

Reply to Parliament Question No 1370 for 28.11.2024 for Lok Sabha regarding “Filling of Vacancies” in respect of Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL):

Q no. (a): whether the Government has taken adequate steps to fill up the vacancies falling under the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas and all its PSUs, allied offices and if so, the details thereof;

Reply: Ministry to reply.
[NRL is conducting recruitment drives every year to fill up the vacancies, if any.]

Q no. (b): the incumbency position as on 01.10.2024 in respect of all Aided Institutes, all Public sector Undertakings under the aegis of Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas; and

Reply: Ministry to reply.
[The incumbency position as on 01.10.2024 in respect of NRL is 1067.]

Q no. (c): whether the Government has initiated any special recruitment drive for filling up of vacancies in SC/ST/OBC and Minority communities and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Reply: Ministry to reply.
[NRL initiates special recruitment drive for fill up of vacancies in SC/ST/OBC and Minority communities whenever required. The last special recruitment drive was conducted for PwBD in December, 2023 and further such drives are planned.]

Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL) is a Public Sector Enterprise with a 3.0 MMTPA petroleum refinery at Numaligarh in Golaghat district of Assam. Present shareholding pattern of NRL is Oil India Limited (OIL) – 69.63%, Govt. of Assam (GoA) – 26% and Engineers India Ltd (EIL) – 4.37%.
