

Reply to Parliament Question No 8776 for 20.03.2025 for Lok Sabha regarding “Wave Energy Projects” in respect of Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL):

Q no. (a): the steps that would be taken to scale up wave energy projects from pilot to commercial-scale installations;
