Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

3. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses
Pre-Qualification Criteria:

PQC for Non-IBR Valves:

The bidder shall be an approved certificate holder of ASME UV Certificate for Manufacturing of Pressure Vessel Pressure Relief Valves. The UV certificate issued by ASME and valid as on the bid closing date shall have to be furnished by the bidder.

PQC for IBR Valves:

The bidder shall have to produce Form III-C & Form III item no. 8 (Details of the Safety Valves & Test Results) issued by competent IBR authority against any of its past supplies along with Data Sheet of the referred safety valve.

Delivery Period:

Within 90 Days of purchase order.

Note :

Bidder must provide duly filled, signed and sealed ATC document & Annexure attached therewith.

CORRIGENDUM -1 (13.10.2023)

With reference to the above Tender, the below amendments to the Tender Terms/ Data sheets may kindly be noted.

1. BOQ Sl. No.30 corresponds to item 04-PSV-1608. The datasheet of referred PSV has been furnished in the Tender Specification Document.
2. For BOQ Sl. Nos. 70 & 240, Safety Valve Tags 07-PSV-1401/1402 & 07-PSV-1301/1302, Safety Valves offered with Overpressures of either 3% or 5% shall be acceptable.
3. For BOQ Sl. No. 250, Safety Valve Tag 07-PSV-1206, Safety Valve offered with Overpressure of either 3% or 5% and outlet size of either 2 inch or 2.5 inch or 3 inch shall be acceptable.
4. For BOQ Sl. No. 300, Safety Valve Tag 04-PSV-7002A/B, the revised capacity to be considered for the Sa

fety Valve is 4200 LPM or more.

5. For BOQ Sl. No. 110, Safety Valve Tag 45-PSV-3001,3002,3003,3004 S, commissioning spares and 2 years mandatory spares as mentioned in the datasheet need not be supplied and therefore need not be considered in the Safety Valve price quote.

6. BOQ SL. No. 310, Safety Valve Tag 04-PSV-7910, revised set pressure to be considered is 35 kg/cm² G. The outlet size of the offered Safety valve can be either 2.5 inches or 3 inches.

This Corrigendum shall supersede the data provided in the respective PSV datasheets in the Tender.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause(s) incorporated by the Buyer regarding following shall be treated as null and void and would not be considered as part of bid:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
