- i) The vendor shall be a manufacturer of the product and shall submit necessary certificate in support.
- ii) The vendor shall have supplied the product to any refinery or in hydrocarbon service and shall submit past purchase order copies as documentary evidence.

Note: The vendor shall submit all necessary documents as mentioned in the prequalification criteria along with their un-priced techno-commercial bid to qualify to participate in the tender and in case of failure, NRL have the rights to reject the offer without any further correspondence.

6. TENDERS FROM MICRO AND SMALL ENTERPRISES (MSEs):

Note: Incase any bidder does not quote both the items in BOQ or does not stand technocommercially acceptable for both the indented items in BOQ, their offer shall not be considered for further evaluation.

8. **GENERAL**:

- i) Bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings. Bidder to submit the self certificate in this regard.
- ii) Agencies submitting their bids shall not be on Holiday list of NRL.
- iii) Consortium/Joint venture bids shall not be accepted.
- iv) Canvassing in any other form by the bidder or by any other agency on their behalf may lead to disqualification of their bid.
- v) In case any of the document/information(s) furnished by a bidder are found to be false/forged, such bidder shall be kept in holiday list/ black list apart from other penal actions as deemed fit by NRL.
- vi) NRL reserves the right to defer the date/time of opening of the offer; to make changes in the terms & conditions of tender document and to reject any or all bids without assigning any reason thereof.
