The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

The Bidder shall have experience of successfully executed ** similar nature of job to any Indian Crude Oil refinery /Petrochemicals /Fertilizer /O&G PSU plant directly or through project consultant(s) , during preceding 10 years counting prior to tender due date.

**** Similar Nature:** Supply and installation of column/ pressure vessel or column/ pressure vessel segment of size i.e. Inner diameter not less than 2400 mm and Thickness not less than 12 mm.

- Against PQC, Bidder is required to submit relevant Purchase order copy(s) and invoices / Inspection Release Notes / completion certificates against the same purchase order(s) as a proof of meeting this requirement.

3. Key Topics:

1. Meeting Introduction: Manab introduced the meeting, stating that it is being recorded and transcribed. He mentioned the participants from both the commercial and technical sides, including Gauri Sankar Nath and Bidyut Kaman.

2. Tender Details: Manab provided details about the tender, including its publication date, validity of offer, and the requirement for bidders to submit 3% PBG. He also mentioned the implementation of the Make In India (MII) and MSE policies.

3. **Scope of Work:** Manab and Bidyut explained the scope of work, which includes the supply and installation of two columns. They emphasized that all fabrications and inspections will be done at the vendor's site, and TPI is applicable during both fabrication and installation.

4. **Technical Queries:** Pandey raised technical queries about the maintenance activities, including the dismantling and reassembly of lines and structures. Bidyut clarified that tray replacement is not included and will be done by another party.

5. **Drawings and Specifications:** Gauri shared the drawings and specifications for the columns, explaining the modifications required for the nozzles and vortex breaker. Pandey confirmed his understanding of the requirements.

6. **Vendor Responsibilities:** Gauri outlined the vendor's responsibilities, including the removal and installation of column segments, lifting of CC-5, and reassembly of dismantled parts. He also mentioned the requirement for vendors to develop a quality assurance plan and get it approved by NRL.

7. **TPI and Inspection:** Gauri and Bidyut discussed the TPI and inspection requirements, stating that all materials must be inspected by TPI and approved by NRL before dispatch. They also mentioned that NRL may deploy additional TPI at their own cost.

8. **Payment Terms:** Manab clarified the payment terms, stating that 80% of the payment will be made after the receipt and acceptance of materials, with no advance payment.

9. **Site Visit:** Pandey inquired about the possibility of a site visit, and Gauri confirmed that it is allowed and mentioned in the tender document. Vendors are required to communicate their specific crane requirements in the technical bid.

10. **Column Replacement Procedure:** THE KCP LIMITED raised a query about the procedure for replacing the bottom tori spherical descent of CC-5. Gauri clarified that the vendor can choose the procedure, but all related tasks must be done by the vendor, with NRL providing the crane.

11. **Meeting Conclusion:** Manab concluded the meeting, stating that the tender document is comprehensive, and no additional queries or corrigendum are required. He thanked all participants for their involvement.

8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
