8. Rates: Firm rate should be quoted in figures in the Bill of Quantity (BOQ) provided with this tender document at http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app. Bidders are advised to download this BoQ as it is, and quote their offer/rates in the permitted column and upload the same in the Priced bid. Bidder shall not tamper/modify the downloaded priced bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered/modified in any manner, offer will be completely rejected and EMD (If Applicable) would be forfeited, and tenderer is liable to be banned from doing business with NRL.

Note:

- Any field in the online priced bid (BoQ) is left blank or =0, the charge, tax or duty shall be considered as either inclusive, nil or not applicable. Charges quoted elsewhere may be ignored in priced bid evaluation and shall not be borne by NRL.
- ❖ In case rate of GST is not selected/selected incorrectly from the dropdown list of BOQ; evaluation shall be done with correct GST rate assessed by NRL.
- No subsequent revision in the BoQ is possible after final submission. Any services, charges, taxes and duties left unquoted shall be deemed to be inclusive in the quoted price.
- Any new or additional taxes / duties and any increase in the existing taxes / duties imposed after the contractual delivery date shall be to Bidder's account whereas any corresponding decrease shall be passed on to the Owner.
- Currency for the Bidding shall be INR (Indian Rupee Rate).

- Comparison shall be made against the final Landing Costs at NRL Site (including all other applicable charges like P & F, Transportation charge, TPI charge, Transit Insurance etc.-as mentioned in BOQ).
- Splitting of quantity shall be done in accordance with the Purchase Preference Policy for MSE and MII (PPLC), as applicable in the tender.
- **9. Contract Performance Security (CPS)**: Applicable for this tender.

The successful bidder must submit Contract Performance Security (CPS) @ 3% of contract value (refer GPC of NRL for details) within 10 days from the date of notification of the award (LOA).

Same may be deposited in the form of a BG in prescribed format (provided in Annexure-XX-A) or through online transfer to the designated bank account of NRL. Detailed Work Order shall be issued/signed after receipt and verification of the requisite contract performance security. Non-submission of CPS within the provided timeline may lead to termination of award, holiday listing and forfeiture of EMD (If Applicable) and other penal actions for breach of contract.

- 12. Special tender clause on procurement from a bidder from a country which shares land border with India:

- **13. Any contractor, consultants, service provider, vendor who is required to deploy their employees, executives, workers, experts etc. at Numaligarh Refinery premises for execution of any work or training shall register in the "Saral Pravesh" system and apply for gate passes through this platform. Respective EICs may be contacted for further details after issuance of LOA / Work Order.
- **14. Trade Receivables Discounting System (TReDS):** Interested bidders are requested to on-board their firm in the TReDS platform and may communicate to NRL in order to avail the facilities that the portal provides.
- **15. Integrity Pact:** All pages of the Integrity Pact are to be returned by the bidder (along with the technical bid) duly signed by the same signatory who signed the bid, i.e., who is duly authorized to sign the bid and to make binding commitments on behalf of his company. Any bid of estimated value of Rs. 1 Crore and above not accompanied by Integrity Pact duly signed by the bidder or the bidder not agreeing to submit a copy of the signed integrity pact shall be considered to be a non-responsive bid and shall be rejected. In case any bidder who has signed the integrity pact and subsequently makes any transgression of this code, the bidder is liable for punitive actions such as cancellation of contracts, banning and blacklisting and so on.

16. Price, Taxes, Duties: Without prejudice to stipulations in General Purchase Condition, the bidder should quote firm prices including all taxes. It is for the Bidder to assess and ascertain the rate of above taxes & duties applicable on quoted items. It is clearly understood that Owner will not have any additional liability towards payment of above taxes & duties which are based on Bidder's wrong assessment / interpretation of applicability of said taxes & duties.

However, GST as applicable will be loaded extra by NRL on the quoted value.

The Bidder shall quote in Indian Rupees and shall be paid in Indian Rupees only.

If there is delay beyond contractual completion period for reasons attributable to Contractor, any increase in taxes & duties will be borne by the Contractor and any decrease shall be passed on to Owner.

17. Clarification of bidding document/ conditions

- a) Although the details presented in this Bidding document `consisting of Conditions of Contract, Scope of Work, Technical Specifications, Drawings etc. which have been compiled with all reasonable care, it is the Bidder's responsibility to ensure that the information provided is adequate and clearly understood.
- b) Bidder shall examine the Bidding document thoroughly in all respect and if any conflict, discrepancy, ambiguity, error or omission is observed, Bidder may request information/ clarification of the Bidding Document in writing through E-mail so as to reach office of NRL not later than 07 days prior to the last date for submission of bids mentioned above.
- c) Where there is disqualification of bidder on non-meeting techno-commercial requirement bidder may submit any representation within 48 hours from the date of uploading technical recommendation (TR).
- d) NRL may respond in writing to any request for any information or clarification or query on the bidding conditions, bidding process and/or rejection of its bid directly to the concerned bidder or by publishing in the e-tendering portal depending on the nature & content of the information/clarification sought.
- e) Offers received from bidders who are on holiday list by NRL/MOPNG shall not be considered. Accordingly, the bidder shall submit a self-declaration as per format enclosed with Tender Document (Refer 6C). It may be noted that if this declaration is found to be false, NRL shall have the right to reject bidder's offer, and if the bid has resulted in a contract, the contract is liable to be terminated.
- f) Any failure by Bidder to comply with the aforesaid requirement shall not excuse the Bidder, after subsequent award of contract, from execution in accordance with the contract.
- g) Bidders are requested to resolve all their clarifications/queries to the Bidding Document before submission of bid and submit their bid in total compliance to Bidding Document without any deviation /stipulation /clarification /assumption.
- h) The responses to Bidder's queries/ clarifications raised will be furnished as expeditiously as possible in the form of Corrigendum/Addendum. Any modification of the Bidding Document, which may become necessary as a result of the bidder's query, or for any reason at NRL's initiative, shall be published as a Corrigendum/Addendum which shall form a part of the Bidding document. Bidder shall submit a copy of all the Corrigendum/Addendum duly signed and stamped in token of his acceptance. Bidder shall consider its impact in his bid / submit revised bid within the last bid submission date & time. Bids submitted without all Corrigendum/Addendum are liable to be rejected.
- i) The bidder (s) or his designated representative, who have downloaded the bid document are invited to attend a PRE-BID MEETING (if applicable) as per the details given in the NIT. The purpose of meeting will be to clarify issues and to answer queries on any matter that may be raised at that stage. Further, the minutes of the pre-bid meeting will form a part of the Tender, and the bidder needs to submit the same duly signed & sealed during unpriced offer.

18. Other Terms & Conditions:

a) Tenderer will fill up the all annexure attached to this Detailed Tender Notice clearly and sign every page of this Detailed Tender Notice (or digitally sign the filled-in bid document file) before submission of the tender. All requisite supporting documents should be enclosed. Tender in which any of the required particulars and prescribed information are missing or are incomplete, are liable to be rejected.

- b) NRL adopts a practice to verify documents submitted by L1 (successful) bidder in support of bidder's credential against PQC. Authentication may be verified with the issuing authorities, by way of direct communication to NRL over official e-mail IDs / Original letter of authentication by post. Bidders may also follow up with the issuing authority for eliciting early response. If documents remain unauthenticated till given time line, NRL reserves the right to reject the bid. Proper address for communication, including e-mail ID of the issuing authority should be provided along the tender document.
- c) Offer will be considered only when NRL is satisfied with experience and capability of the tenderer to take up this work.
- d) Consortium/Joint venture bids shall not be accepted.
- e) Canvassing in any other form by the bidder or by any other agency on their behalf may lead to disqualification of their bid.
- f) In case any of the document/information(s) furnished by a bidder are found to be false/forged, such bidder shall be kept in holiday list/ blacklist apart from other penal actions as deemed fit by NRL.
- g) In case any bidder is found to be involved cartel formation, his bid will not be considered for evaluation/placement of order. Such bidder will also be debarred from bidding in future.
