Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. 2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Generic

Bidder financial standing: The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

3. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

4. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (PQC):

The bidder must have experience of supplying Anhydrous Ammonia (NH₃) Gas in last 10 years in PSUs, Govt. Industries, Fertilizers, or any kind of reputed industries. Bidder should submit at least 01 (one) Purchase order copy not older than 10 years (as on first due date of the tender) issued by any reputed industries for supply of Anhydrous Ammonia (NH₃).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS (COMMERCIAL):

1. Price basis: FOR NRL Site, Numaligarh.

2. Scope of Supply: Supply of 700 Kg of Anhydrous Ammonia (NH₃) in packaging of cylinders.

3. Payment Terms:

Payment shall be released within 30 days from the date of receipt and acceptance of the material along with the relevant documents.

Note: Bidders to note that NRL shall release all payments through e- payment mode (RTGS / NEFT) only and not through any other mode.

4. Price reduction clause due to delayed delivery: In case of delay in delivery, NRL may at its option, recover from the bidder price reduction of 0.5% of the value of delayed goods per week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of 5% of the total order value of goods.

5. Third Party Inspection (TPI): Not Required.

6. Delivery schedule:

The material is to be supplied in two staggered basis. 50% of the total delivery amount to be delivered in 1st lot. Subsequent amount to be supplied based on separate advice from EIC over mail or any other mode of written communications. Tentative delivery of second lot will be in a gap of 1 year.

The delivery period shall be 2 months from the date of PO/GEM order for the 1st lot and the second lot is to be delivered within two months of requisition intimation from EIC of NRL.

NOTE: The installation of individual displays may be necessitated to be carried out separately, contingent upon site availability. Consequently, the bidder is obligated to dispatch its installation team multiple times, in accordance with the directives of the Engineer-in-Charge (E-I-C). The bidder is advised to anticipate a minimum of five distinct visits by the installation team and to incorporate associated expenses into their quotation accordingly. This section shall be read in conjunction with any other relevant sections/provisions of this document. In case of ambiguity, the decision of E-I-C shall be final and binding on the bidder.

7. Guaranty / Warranty/ Shelf life: Shelf life of the Anhydrous Ammonia (NH₃) shall be minimum 1 year. Shelf-life certificate needs to be submitted.

8. General Terms and Conditions:

- i) NRL adopts a practice to verify documents submitted by L1 (successful) bidder in support of bidder's credential against PQC. Authentication may be verified with the issuing authorities, by way of direct communication to NRL over official e-mail IDs / Original letter of authentication by post. Bidders may also follow up with the issuing authority for eliciting early response. If documents remain unauthenticated till given timeline, NRL reserves the right to reject the bid. Proper address for communication, including e-mail ID of the issuing authority should be provided along the tender document.
 - ii) Consortium/Joint venture bids shall not be accepted.
 - iii) Canvassing in any other form by the bidder or by any other agency on their behalf may lead to disqualification of their bid.
 - iv) In case any of the document/information(s) furnished by a bidder are found

nd to be false/forged, such bidder shall be kept in holiday list/ blacklist apart from other penal actions as deemed fit by NRL.

- v) In case any bidder is found to be involved cartel formation, his bid will not be considered for evaluation/placement of order. Such bidder will also be debarred from bidding in future.
- vi) Bidders who are on holiday list by NRL or MoPNG will not be considered. Accordingly, the bidder shall submit a self-declaration as per the format enclosed with the bid. It may be noted that if this declaration is found to be false, NRL shall have the right to reject the bidder's offer, and if the bid has resulted in a contract, the contract is liable to be terminated.
- vii) Printed terms and conditions, if any, submitted with the offer by the bidder shall be ignored and shall not be applicable in the event of order. In case of contradiction between the terms & conditions mentioned elsewhere in the offer by the bidder and terms and conditions mentioned in the bid document and NRL GPC; terms & conditions mentioned in the bid document and NRL GPC shall prevail. Moreover, rates & taxes indicated in the BOQ shall prevail.
- viii) Govt. has reduced the aggregate turnover for applicability of E-invoices from earlier limit Rs.10 crores to Rs. 5 crores, which will be effective from 1st August '2023. In view above, all concerns are requested to raise only E-invoice to NRL with all requisite details like IRN, QR code etc. Non-complied invoices shall not be accepted for further processing.
- ix) All other terms and conditions of this tender shall be governed by NRL GPC 2023 (Indigenous). May find NRL's 'General Purchase Conditions (Indigenous)' in the link:
