Payment Term of the Tender: Prospective bidders have requested for amendment of payment term as NRL will look into it. In case of any below: amendment to payment term, Corrigendum to NIT will be issued in e-tender portal. At the time of delivery of the chassis at vendor's works by the chassis manufacturer, 20% of total order value will be released to the vendor against submission of chassis invoice procured in the name of NRL and on receipt of inspection and clearance by the Third Party Inspection agency (TPIA) and on submission of Advance Bank Guarantee (as per NRL's standard format) for equivalent amount. valid till contractual completion period (till commissioning) plus 03 (three) months claim period. 80% order value along with 100% taxes & duties will be released after delivery and successful commissioning of fire tenders at NRL Site. 3. Pre-Qualification Criteria (PQC): Prospective → NRL intimated that. PQC clause no. 3.2 , 2<sup>nd</sup> bidder have requested for clarity on the requirement point to be read as below: of end user certificate requirement in PQC clause no. 3.2, 2<sup>nd</sup> point of NIT. Bidder will produce End User Certificate on satisfactory performance of Water Tower/ Boom Water Tower of the offered make having minimum height 10-16 meters installed at firefighting vehicle.
