1.0 Introduction

Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL), a subsidiary of Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL) presently operates a 3.0 MMTPA refinery at Golaghat, Assam.

Numaligarh Refinery Limited has embarked on plan to expand its refining capacity from current 3 MMTPA to 9 MMTPA by installing a 6MMTPA capacity refinery and associated crude oil terminals & pipeline and has appointed M/s. Technip India Limited (TPIL) as Project Management Consultant (Managing PMC) to provide PMC services.

For this Expansion Project, NRL has identified list of ODC/OWC to be transported from Haldia port/ Kolkata Port to NRL site and Installation of these Equipments in respective Units of NREP.

2.0 Brief Scope of Work

The scope consists of Project Management, Transportation Engineering, and multimodal transportation including custom clearances of ODC/OWCs from Haldia port / Kolkata Port to NRL site,located at Golaghat District, Assam as mentioned in Form SP1 and Erection/Installation in respective Units of NREP as mentioned in Form SP2 of Price Schedule attached in the Tender document.

Bidder to note that ODC/OWC will be shipped by ODC/OWC manufactures/other agency(shall be called as supplier hereafter) up to Haldia Port/Kolkata Port Accordingly, bidder will be required to take delivery of the ODC/OWC's on his barge from hooks of suppliers's Vessels at Haldia Port /Kolkata Port.After taking delivery of the ODC/OWCs on his river barge, bidder will be required to transport the ODC/OWC from the respective port through various rivers and channels of Bangladesh and then through Brahmaputra river -National Water way-2 until Dhansiri Mukh and from Dhansiri mukh to NRL Jetty through Dhansiri river. The ODC/OWC shall be unloaded at NRL jetty and then transported to NRL site by road, crossing Kaliyani river through causeway/ temporary bridge. ODC/OWC could be transported over Kaliyani Temporary Bridge with bridge jumper/structural arrangement when the water in Kalyani river is at safe level. Bridge jumper over Kaliyani River will have to be erected prior to transportation and the same shall be dismantled if required depending on the water level during monsoon. The bridge jumper/ structural member shall be reinstalled again for transportation of ODC/OWC once the water is at safe level. The ODC/OWC thus transported to site shall be erected/installed, aligned and grouted on the foundation by the bidder including making arrangement for heavy lift cranes. The cumstom clearance, if required, at Haldia/ Kolkata, Bangladesh and other ports shall have to be arranged by the bidder.

The job is splited into two parts as mentioned below,

3.0 Bidder Qualification Requirement (BQC)

Bidder(s) who meet all of the following criteria as specified in clauses below shall be qualified for participating in this tender and shall submit supporting documents as detailed in the tender. Proposal submitted by bidders who qualify as per the following criteria shall be technically and commercially evaluated.

3.1 Technical Criteria

The bidder should have successfully executed/ completed "*Similar Work" in last 10 years, starting from date of completion of the work till the last day of the preceding month of initial bid due date.

*Simillar Work applicable for Part -A

Bidder must have successfully completed multimodal transportation of OWC equipment in India of minimum weight 450 MT in Single piece through water ways and road using SPMT/MAHT. Additionally bidder must have successfully completed transportation through river barges and road ODC/OWC equipments in India of min 150MT weight in single piece.

*Simillar Work applicable for Part -B

- a) Bidder shall have experience in erection of following size ODC/OWC equipment in single piece in an industrial plant
 - OWC of weighing minimum 450MT and ODC of minimum length 45 meter.

Note:

Bidder participating for both Part A and Part B shall meet both the above technical criterias.

3.2 Commercial Criteria : Past Experience

e. If the bidder's working capital is inadequate, the bidder should furnish a letter for line of credit from any scheduled bank in India or a commercial bank having net worth not less than INR 100 Crore, confirming the availability of the fund based line of credit for the respective amount specified above, irrespective of overall position of the working capital.

- b) The bidder must submit copy (ies) financial documents Trading and P/L account(s) along with the un-priced bid in support of the above criteria.
- c) In case the last financial year closing date is within 9 months of bid due date and audited annual financial report of immediate preceding financial year is not available, bidder has the option to submit the financial details of the three previous years immediately prior to the last financial year. Otherwise, it is compulsory to submit the financial details of the immediate three preceding financial years.
- d) Example, in case, audited annual financial report of immediate preceding financial year (year ending 31st March) is not available and where bid closing date is up to 31st December, the financial details of the three previous years immediately prior to the last financial year may be submitted. 3.4 BID EVALUATION METHODOLOGY:

Bidder(s) have the option to quote either for Part A(all items as per Form SP1) or Part B(all items as per Form SP2) or combined Part A & Part B(all items as per Form SP3).

Partial bid either in Part A or Part B or combined Part A and Part B shall be rejected.

The unpriced techno-commercial bids for Part A,Part B and combined Part A and Part B shall be opened together.

The techno-commercial evaluation shall be carried out as per BQC mentioned in this NIT.The price bids of techno-commercially qualified bidders of Part A,Part B and combined Part A and Part B shall be opened together.Offers shall be evaluated on overall least cost basis to NRL as detailed below:

- a) The lowest price with applicable loading against Part A (SP1), Part B (SP2)and combined Part A & Part B (SP3) as per SOP shall be evaluated.
- b) The total evaluated lowest prices(L1) against Part A (SP1) and Part B (SP2) shall be compared with the total evaluated lowest prices(L1) for Combined Part A and Part B (SP3) and the award shall be made under the least cost option. In case the evaluated L1 price against Part A and Part B is found to be lesser, the job shall be awarded to the L1 bidders of respective parts i.e. Part A & Part B; whereas in case the L1 price for

Combined Part A and Part B is lowest, the job shall be awarded to the L1 bidder for Combined Part A and Part B.

Note:

1. After evaluation on least cost option (as per the methodology indicated under 3.4(a)&(b) above), If the quoted rates are high, negotiations may be conducted with L-1 bidder. The work shall be awarded to L-1 (being lowest) at quoted/negotiated rates only.

3.5 General Notes on BQC

- 3.5.1 Bidder can be an Indian Company or Indian Subsidiary of a Foreign Company/ Group company (termed as parent company).
- 3.5.2 Bidder can also use the credentials of their parent company to qualify the BQC requirements. In such case, following conditions must be complied by the bidder
 - a) The Bid shall be signed by authorized signatory of the Indian Subsidiary.
 - b) The Bidder shall provide written undertaking on the responsibilities taken by the parent company.
- 3.5.3 In case the bidder uses the Technical credentials of its Parent Company, for meeting the BQC, then both the parties i.e. bidder and Parent Company shall be jointly and severally liable for the performance of the contract. A Notarized Declaration by each such party to this effect shall be submitted with the bid under the signature of an authorized signatory of the respective parties mentioned above as per the format attached at Annexure –XVIII-A to ITB, which shall be part of the bid document and contract awarded to successful bidder later on.
- 3.5.4 In case the Parent Company of the bidder is not able to execute the Notarized Declaration as mentioned above, then the Parent Company of the Bidder shall submit along with the bid a Corporate Guarantee, as per the format herewith at Annexure XVIII-B to ITB, which will be effective in case the bid is successful and this Corporate Guarantee shall be part of the contract awarded to the successful bidder.
- 3.5.5 The Bidder shall be established in India for at least last 5 Years.
- 3.5.6 The consortium Formation shall not be allowed.
- 3.5.7 Failure to enter into agreement between the bidder and Parent company within 3 week or failure to deploy the suitable vehicle within required time may lead to forfeiture of EMD / SD and termination of contract, subject to decision of competent authority at NRL. In such an event NRL reserves the right to engage trailers/Barges/Ships from

- 4.1 Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence by way of copies of work orders /Relevant pages of contracts, completion certificates from their clients, division of responsibilities for the work performed, completion certificate, MOU document/ commitment letters, Annual Reports containing audited balance sheets including Profit and Loss Accounts statement, in support of their fulfilling the qualification criteria.
 - In absence of such documents, NRL reserve the right to reject the Bid without making any reference to the Bidder or assigning any reason what-so-ever.
- 4.2 All documents furnished by the bidder in support of meeting the BQC (including MSE Certificate) shall be submitted/uploaded in a separate folder titled "Documents towards BQC", duly signed and stamped by the bidder (in case of proprietorship firm) or "Power of Attorney" holder in case of Partnership /firm/Company. Copy of such "Power of Attorney" shall also be furnished with the unpriced bid.

5 Earnest Money Deposit:

Instructions for Online Bid Submission

Appendix-A

As per the directives of Department of Expenditure, this tender document has been published on the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: https://eprocure.gov.in). The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at: https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app.

REGISTRATION

- 1) Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app) by clicking on the link "Online Bidder Enrolment" on the CPP Portal is free of charge.
- 2) As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- 3) Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- 4) Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / TCS / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.
- 5) Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC's to others which may lead to misuse.
- 6) Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

- 1) There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, organization name, location, date, value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as organization name, form of contract, location, date, other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- 2) Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective 'My Tenders' folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / e-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.

3) The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

PREPARATION OF BIDS

- 1) Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.
- 2) Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents - including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
- 3) Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option.
- 4) To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use "My Space" area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the "My Space" area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 1) Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that he/she upload the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- 2) The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- 3) Bidder has to select the payment option as "offline" to pay the tender fee / EMD as applicable and enter details of the instrument.
- 4) Bidder(s) must follow the following for submission of online EMD:

 - Bidder will receive system generate One Time Password (OTP) on their registered mobile number. In case not receiving of OTP please click Regenerate OTP and login.

- After login Screen bidder can search the tenders and proceed for EMD payment.
- Bidders' have to click on Payment Dashboard option available under Action tab
- Payment Dashboard Click on Pay to proceed further for the selection of payment mode.
- Smart Hub Bidders' can select the online payment and click on Pay to proceed further.
- After click on Pay Bidder will get an option for Cards and Net Banking. Bidders
 can select their preference and proceed further for the payment.
- On successful payment bidder will receive system generated message on screen stating "EMD paid successfully"
- Bidders' can also download the Payment receipt from Payment Dashboard.
- Downloaded payment receipt Bidders' can easily print the receipt and use it for their bidding purpose.
- Since the HDFC Bank payment gateway is not under the CPPP, so the payment mode is mentioned as offline (BG) in the CPP portal. Bidder has to make a dummy entry in the EMD fields of CPPP by putting 'Transaction ID' (HDFC Bank payment receipt) as instrument no., payment date as issue date, any date as expiry date, and bank name as issuer details. Please upload the EMD payment receipt along with technical bid.

A receipt will be generated after successful payment (irrespective of the mode of payment). Bidder can take print out for onward submission with tender as well as save a soft copy of the receipt.

Foreign Bidders may submit the EMD wither in the form of crossed Demand Draft in favour of "Numaligarh Refinery Limited" payable at Numaligarh or Bank Guarantee (BG). BG shall be submitted from any Indian scheduled bank which includes Indian branch of foreign bank recognized as scheduled bank by RBI. Bids without the requisite EMD as mentioned above shall be rejected.

There will be no waiver of EMD for Public Sector Undertaking of Central/State Government Undertakings. EMD shall be valid for a period of 08 (Eight) months from the final bid due date for submission of Bids.

- Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the priced bid have been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the white colored (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.
- 2) The server time (which is displayed on the bidders' dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.

- 3) All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128 bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done
- 4) The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.
- 5) Upon the successful and timely submission of bids, the portal will give a successful bid submission message & a bid summary will be displayed with the bid no. and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.
- 6) The bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement of the submission of the bid. This acknowledgement may be used as an entry pass for any bid opening meetings.

ASSISTANCE TO BIDDERS

- Any queries relating to the tender document and the terms and conditions contained therein should be addressed to the Tender Inviting Authority for a tender or the relevant contact person indicated in the tender.

Special Instructions to the Bidders for the e-submission of the bids online through e-Procurement Portal:

- I. Bidder should do Online Enrolment in this Portal using the option Click Here to enroll available in the Home Page. Then the Digital Signature enrolment has to be done with the e-token, after logging into the portal. The e-token may be obtained from one of the authorized Certifying Authorities such as eMudhraCA/GNFC/IDRBT/MTNLTrustline/SafeScrpt/TCS.
- II. Bidder then logs into the portal giving user id / password chosen during enrolment.
- III. The e-token that is registered should be used by the bidder and should not be misused by others.
- IV. DSC once mapped to an account cannot be remapped to any other account. It can only be
- V. Inactivated.
- VI. The Bidders can update well in advance, the documents such as certificates, purchase order details etc., under **My Documents** option and these can be selected as per tender requirements and then attached along with bid documents during bid submission. This will ensure lesser upload of bid documents.
- VII. After downloading / getting the tender schedules, the Bidder should go through them carefully and then submit the documents as per the tender document, otherwise, the bid will be rejected.

- IX. If there are any clarifications, this may be obtained online through the e-Procurement Portal, or through the contact details given in the tender document. Bidder should take into account of the corrigendum published before submitting the bids online.
- X. Bidder, in advance, should prepare the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the nder edule and they should be in PDF/XLS/RAR/DWF formats. If there is more than one document,
- XI. they can be clubbed together.
- XII. Bidder should arrange for the EMD as specified in the tender.
- XIII. The bidder reads the terms and conditions and accepts the same to proceed further to submit the bids The bidder has to submit the tender document(s) online well in advance before the prescribed time to avoid any delay or problem during the bid submission process.
- XIV. There is no limit on the size of the file uploaded at the server end. However, the upload is decided on the Memory available at the Client System as well as the Network bandwidth available at the client side at that point of time. In order to reduce the file size, bidders are suggested to scan the documents in 75-100 DPI so that the clarity is maintained and also the size of file also gets reduced. This will help in quick uploading even at very low bandwidth speeds.
- XV. It is important to note that, the bidder has to Click on the Freeze Bid Button, to ensure that he/she completes the Bid Submission Process. Bids Which are not Frozen are considered as
- XVI. Incomplete/Invalid bids and are not considered for evaluation purposes.
- XVII. In case of Offline payments, the details of the Earnest Money Deposit(EMD) document submitted physically to the Department and the scanned copies furnished at the time of bid submission online should be the same otherwise the Tender will be summarily rejected
- XVIII. The **Tender Inviting Authority (TIA)** will not be held responsible for any sort of delay or the difficulties faced during the submission of bids online by the bidders due to local issues.
 - XIX. The bidder may submit the bid documents online mode only, through this portal. Offline documents will not be handled through this system.
 - XX. At the time of freezing the bid, the e-Procurement system will give a successful bid updating message after uploading all the bid documents submitted and then a bid summary will be shown with the bid no, date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details. The documents submitted by the bidders will be digitally signed using the e-token of the bidder and then submitted.
 - XXI. After the bid submission, the bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement as a token of the submission of the bid. The bid summary will act as a proof of bid submission for a tender floated and will also act as an entry point to participate in the bid opening event.
- XXII. Successful bid submission from the system means, the bids as uploaded by the bidder is received and stored in the system. System does not certify for its correctness.
- XXIII. The bidder should see that the bid documents submitted should be free from virus and if the documents could not be opened, due to virus, during tender opening, the bid is liable to be rejected The time that is displayed from the server clock at the top of the tender Portal, will be valid for all actions of requesting bid submission, bid
