Online offer in **Two Bid** is invited by Numaligarh Refinery Ltd. for the work as detailed below:

1. Name of the work : Unloading of old Catalyst & reloading of new Catalyst in all the

reactors in Motor Spirit Plant (MSP) at Numaligarh Refinery

Limited, Assam (COMM/C26/6459).

2. **Earnest Money Deposit**: **Rs. 49,000/-**(Rupees Forty Nine Thousand only)

(The EMD must be submitted on line within 06.05.2019. If the EMD is not received within the stipulated date, offer shall not be considered for opening). In case of MSE registered bidders—bidder has to have the UAM (Udyog Aadhaar

Memorandum) no. registered on CPP Portal.

3. **Contractual Period**: The subject job shall be completed in 15 (Fifteen) days (Approx.) from the date of site handover excluding mobilization time. Mobilization includes manpower reaching at site, preparation for work and making everything ready for taking work permit. Thereafter execution of the job till hand over to operation shall not take more than 15 days. Subsequent upon handover to operation, NRL need to check the performance of the reactor as per sequence of operation for the unit. Demobilization shall be done accordingly based on the performance.

4. **Bid submission end date online**: Up to 11 AM on **06.05. 2019.**

5. **Bid opening date** : After 11AM on **07.05.2019**

6. Place of submission of bid: At e-tender portal i.e. https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app.

7. **Submission of Bid**:

Being an e-tender the bid has to be submitted online in the e-tender portal i.e. **https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app**.Kindly refer **Appendix-A** for the detailed procedure.

The Techno- Commercial Bid & Price Bid needs to be submitted online.

All corrections and alterations in the entries of tender paper shall be signed in full by the tenderer with date. No erasures or over writing are permissible.

8. **Earnest Money**:

The bidder shall deposit Earnest Money Deposit in the **online portal through the link https://easypay.axisbank.co.in/nrli.e. within <u>06.05.2019 at 11.00 hrs</u>. Please note that EMD amount only in online mode is acceptable** and no other mode i.e. offline or hard copy is not acceptable.

Procedure or Process for Online Submission of EMD:

- (i) Bidders will open the link https://easypay.axisbank.co.in/nrl and type the Tender ID for which EMD is to be paid and click on the option "Validate".
- (ii) The web page will auto populate Tender Name, Last Date of Payment, Bid Opening date and EMD (not editable).
- (iii) The bidder will enter his Company/ Firm Name, Address, e-Mail ID, Amount and Mobile Number.
- (iv) The bidder is also required to enter his preferred account No. and IFS Code twice for receiving EMD refund. In case of any mismatch in the account No. or IFS Code entered twice, the web page will prompt the bidder to correct the data and then allow to proceed with payment.
- (v) The Bidder is then required to enter verification code as displayed in the web page and click on the option "Submit".
- (vi) The next Web Page will then display the summary of the EMD payment along with a Unique Reference Number (URN).
- (vii) Bidder is required to accept the payment Terms and Conditions and select his preferred mode of payment from the options provided, viz., Net Banking (Axis Bank or Other Banks), Credit/ Debit Cards or NEFT/RTGS.
- (viii) In case of Net Banking, the bidder will enter his User ID/ Password/ Transaction Password and One time password as per the online payment system of the Bidder's Bank.
- (ix) For Credit/ Debit Card payment, the Bidder will enter his Card Number, Expiry Date, CVV and 'Verified by VISA' or 'Master Secure' password as applicable.
- (x) For bidders selecting the payment option of NEFT/RTGS, the web page will generate a challan with a Dynamic/Virtual Account Number, IFS Code, Account Name and Amount. The bidders can take a print out of this challan or just note the relevant details and initiate the NEFT payment from their Bank.
- (xi) A receipt will be generated after successful payment (irrespective of the mode of payment). Bidder can take print out for onward submission with tender as well as save a soft copy of the receipt.

9. **Scope of work and Supply:**

The scope of work & supply of this work will be in accordance with the Special Conditions of Contract, Schedule of Rates and as per the direction of Engineer-in-charge.

10. **Rate**:

Rate should be quoted as per enclosed Schedule of Rates in Online BOQ.

11. Evaluation criteria:

The tender item is non-splitable and evaluation will be done on overall lowest offer basis.

12. <u>Security deposit</u>:

Contractors have to submit Security deposit as per GCC of NRL.

A sum of 10% of the accepted value of the tender or the actual value of work done whichever is applicable (due to any additional work or any other reasons) shall be deposited by the Contractor as Security Deposit. This may be deposited initially at 2 ½ % of the value of contract (referred as initial security deposit) within 10 days of award of contract and the balance 7 ½ % to be recovered from bill against work done.

13. **Defect Liability Period:** 03 months from date of completion of job.

14. **Measurement of work:**

Payment will be made on the basis of joint measurements, taken by the contractor and certified by Engineer-incharge.

15. **Terms of payment:**

Within 30 days after receipt of invoices complete in all sides. Payment shall be made after successful completion of work based on certification made for payment by E-I-C.

The above payments are subject to deductions towards security deposit, income tax other recoveries as applicable as per terms of the contract.

16. **Price, Taxes, Duties:**

Without prejudice to stipulations in General Conditions of Contract, the bidder should quote firm prices inclusive of all taxes. However, the quoted price will be exclusive of GST. GST as applicable will be loaded by NRL.

17. **Penalty Clause**:

In case the contractor fails to comply with provisions of tender and requirement, penalty (monetary or otherwise) as deemed fit by the Officer-in-charge will be levied as per the provisions in NRL GCC and provisions of the tender and the same shall be final and binding on the contractor.

18. Other terms and conditions:

- (a) Transfer of tender documents issued to one short-listed bidder to another is not permissible. Further, tender containing uncalled for remarks or any additional conditions are liable to be rejected.
- (b) The management of NRL reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders received without assigning any reason thereof.
- (c) Variation in the value of the work will not vitiate the tender agreement.
- (d) The contractor will have to abide by the existing laws applicable to contract works and co-operate with other contractors working at site and will not cause hindrance to other works.
- (e) The contractor shall observe all labour and other statutory rules and regulation of State/Central Govt. in force including the Safety and Environmental rules & regulations. In case of any violations of such laws, rules & regulations, the cost involvement thereof shall exclusively be borne by the contractor and the company shall have no liability whatsoever on this account.
- (f) The contractor should engage skilled and unskilled labourers preferably from the families of displaced persons to the extent available.
- (g) SM(MSP Ops), NRL shall be the Engineer-in-charge of the work and the contractor will have to abide by the instructions of Engineer-in-charge as given from time to time.
- (h) The General Conditions of contract of NRL will be applicable for this contract also. Intending tenderer may see the General Conditions of Contract of NRL at the Commercial Department of NRL site office on any working day during office hours or may visit our website www.nrl.co.in.
- (i) Tenderer will fill up the all annexure attached to this Detailed Tender Notice clearly and sign every page of this Detailed Tender Notice before submission of the tender. Tender in which any of the required particulars and prescribed information are missing or are incomplete, are liable to be rejected.
- (j) One authorized representative of the vendor/contractor may remain present during the tender opening on the due date, time and venue.
- (k) No escalation of contract value, in any form whatsoever will be entertained during the contract period.
- (1) For applicable labour wage at NRL site & other relevant information regarding labour wages, kindly refer 'Circular of Wages for Contract Workmen'. This circular is available at NRL Website www.nrl.co.in (Tenders >TenderManualunder heading "Circular of Wages for Contract Workmen").
- (m) No mobilization advance will be paid to the contractor for execution of this work.
- (n) Insurance shall be effected for all employees of the contractor, engaged in the performance of the subject job.
- (o) The contractor has to accept full & exclusive liability for compliance with all obligations imposed by **Employee State Insurance Act, 1948**.

- (p) The contractor is required to obtain labour license under Contract Labour (R&A) Act, 1970 &PF registration number on awarding the contract.
- (q) The contractor will not engage minor labour below 18 (eighteen) years of age under any circumstances. The contractor will further comply with the provisions of the following act and indemnify the company against all claims, which may arise out of the following Acts, & Rules framed there-under:
 - (i) The Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act,
 - (ii) The Minimum Wages Act.
 - (iii) The contractor has to accept full & exclusive liability for compliance with all obligations imposed by **Employee State Insurance Act, 1948.**
 - (iv) The Workman's Compensation Act.
 - (v) The Payment of Wages Act,
 - (vi) The Payment of Bonus Act,
 - (vii) The Employees Provident Fund & Misc. Provisions Act,

Provident Fund

- a) PF to be deposited against each worker engaged by the contractor. The worker should have valid gate pass against the particular contract. Contractor has to maintain one register for PF.
- b) Contractor has to submit monthly return (ECR) and acknowledgement receipt of the PF deposits along with the bill.
- c) Actual calculated PF amount will be withheld from RA bill in case of non submission of the above document.

ESI Fund

- a) ESI to be deposited against each worker engaged by the contractor .The worker should have valid gate pass against the particular contract. Contractor has to maintain one register for ESI.
- b) Contractor has to submit monthly return and acknowledgement receipt of the ESI deposits along with the bill.
- c) Actual calculated ESI amount will be withheld from RA bill in case of non-submission of the above document.
- (s) In case any of the document/information(s) furnished by a bidder are found to be false/forged, such bidder will be kept in holiday list apart from other penal actions as deemed fit by NRL.
- (t) Agencies who are already blacklisted or against whom there is adverse report on committing criminal offence, their offers will be rejected.

19. **AMENDMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENT:**

- i. NRL may, for any reason whether at his own initiative or in response to the clarification requested by the prospective bidder(s), issue amendment in the form of Addendum during the bidding period or subsequent to receiving the bids. Any Addendum thus issued shall become part of Bidding Document and Bidder shall submit a copy of the Addendum duly signed and stamped in token of his acceptance. Addendum shall be issued to only those bidders, who have been issued the Bidding Document or submitted acknowledgement cum consent letter as per the Performa enclosed in the Bidding Document.
- ii. In case Addendum is issued during the bidding period, Bidder shall consider its impact in his bid. In case Addendum is issued subsequent to receipt of bids, Bidder shall follow the instructions issued along with Addendum with regard to submission of impact on quoted price / revised price, if any.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

Scope of Work:

The scope of work include deployment of all tool and tackles, manpower and render all necessary services, to carry out catalyst replacement job. The job includes but not limited to the following:

Some of the Catalysts are highly sensitive to moisture poisoning even in ppm level. Hence moisture ingress to the reactor to be avoided at all cost and complete job is to be carried out under N2 atmosphere.

Following are the details of catalyst/absorbents/ dryers to be unloaded and loaded with new one. Detail drawing for each of the Reactors are available at site.




Fig 1: 15-RB-001(CRU 1ST REACTOR): SPHERE DIAMETER: 2400 MM




Fig 2: 15-RB-002(CRU 2ND REACTOR): SPHERE DIAMETER: 2700 MM

1. Unloading:

Construction of temporary shed for storage of fresh/ unloaded catalyst drums, catalyst samples,tools & tackles etc. near to the reactor.

Deployment of Vacuum blower assembly, Dust Extractor, loading hoppers etc., and all tools & tackle at the working site.

Installation of the manual unloading equipment with nitrogen connection for nitrogen bleed.

#vacuum unloading equipment will have to be arranged by the contractor and the vacuuming under inert system may be required for CRU & other reactors.

#Blinding of inlet, outlet lines & its associated connections. Removal of top dome & elbow

#Removal of the liquid distribution trays along with the inert balls and catalyst for cleaning.

#Removal of the top layer of inert ceramic balls wherever is required.

#Removal of complete layer of catalyst (Quantity as per the attached excel sheet)

#All the spent catalyst/ceramic balls are to be stored in plastic liners in drums purged with nitrogen. This is essential in view of pyrophoric nature of used catalyst.

#Take samples from various depths of catalyst separately as directed by EIC/licensor for analysis while unloading. The detail sampling procedure will be as per requirement of licensor/ NRL.

#Removal of the bottom layer of inert ceramic balls manually.

#Cleaning of reactor internals like feed diffuser, trays, Johnson screen etc in N2 environment.

#Cleaning of used ceramic balls and assistance in heat treatment (moisture removal) of new ceramic balls as per direction of EIC.

2. Loading of catalyst:

- # Installation of Dense/sock loading equipment with nitrogen connections for nitrogen bleed.
- # Setting up of loading hopper at reactor top. Fit loading pipe and sock to control valve. Set up life support equipment ready for reloading and technician will enter the reactor with required life support equipment ready for reloading.
- # Screening of old catalyst or fresh catalyst if any as per direction of EIC/Licensor
- # Loading of ceramic balls & catalyst is to be carried out as per the instruction of EIC/Licensor.
- # After clearance from EIC, box up internals which are removed for unloading.
- # Boxing up of top dome, de-blinding of inlet & outlet lines and inlet elbow reversal (box-up) for the reactor system after completion of the jobs inside the reactor.
- # Leak testing & hot bolting during start-up.
- # Sample is to be collected from various depths as per the direction of EIC/licensor during loading of fresh catalyst.

Other requirement:

- # Transportation of empty drums/fresh catalyst drums from store to site and safe storage at earmarked place.
- # Shifting of the spent catalyst drums to the location (with in the refinery premises) as advised by EIC.
- # Jobs shall be carried out 24 hours basis. Accordingly manpower shall be arranged.
- # Mobilization time: Mobilization time shall be 25 days from the date of confirmation from NRL.Bidder must mobilize with all the resources (material and manpower) within 25 days of notice period. The Job is planned during the RTA-2019 scheduled in Nov-2019.
- # Contractor has to mobilize all resources as required for the jobs.
- # The contractor has to plan to execute one or more parts of the jobs in parallel. He must submit a detail scheme of execution of entire job, Job safety plan and manpower deployment program with the offer.
- # Entire job shall be subject to stage-wise Inspection and approval of NRL Engineer- In-Charge/Inspection/ Licensor, Particularly before removing / dismantling any reactor internal / catalyst etc the contractor shall apprise NRL EIC/Inspection in written regarding the condition of such internals / catalyst.
- # Cleaning of area after completion of work by removing all scrap and other materials generated to designated place as per direction of EIC.
- # No idle charges for contractor's workmen, tools, equipments deployed for the job, shall be paid in any case.
- # Invoice shall include the price for Mobilization, Demobilization and Execution of the job .

NRL Scope:

- Ø NRL shall provide electricity power board, Nitrogen, scaffolding, gaskets, compressed air, drinking water, empty drums free of cost near the working location. However, Contractor shall have to assist during transportation and supervise to fulfill their requirement.
- Ø NRL shall arrange induction safety training and gate passes.

- Ø NRL shall ensure confine space entry guidelines as per prevailing refinery work permit system.
- Ø NRL shall provide forklift/hydra, crane etc. as required for the job free of cost.
- ** Dense loading will be done using Axens' dense loading apparatus "CATAPAC" and the loading apparatus will be provided by Axens.

Contractors' scope:

- Ø Arrangement of medically fit manpower (The contractor shall have sufficient no. of skilled manpower who have valid license to work under inert atmosphere inside the reactor as the whole job of catalyst unloading and loading to be carried out under N2 atmosphere, catalyst being very sensitive to moisture poisoning. Contractor shall send the bio-data of such skilled persons.)
- Ø Supply of PPE#s
- Ø Arrangement of all the lifting tools & tackles
- Ø Inside 24 V lighting arrangement
- Ø Lodging, boarding, transportation of contractors' employees & workmen.
- Ø Insurance of contractors' employees, workmen, equipment & tools & tackles.
- Ø To follow all safety norms as per HSE norms prevailing within the company from time to time.
- Ø Carrying out of activities as defined in the scope of work.
- Ø Life support system
- Ø Complete vacuum unloading equipment under inert system
- Ø Catalyst loading equipments.
- Ø Tensioning & torqueing equipments.

Any other issues/requirements shall be settled with mutual understanding considering safety and security of the manpower and properties.

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF BIDDERS:

The contractors applying for the subject work should full fill the following criteria:

Bidder must have experience of at least 3 nos of similar job of catalyst replacement under inert nitrogen in refineries or other industries. Bidders must submit the reference list of earlier jobs (of similar nature) executed, with a copy of work order in support of the same, with the offer.

SCOPE OF WORK & SUPPLY:

The scope of work & supply of this work will be in accordance with your offer and as per the direction of Engineer-in-charge.

ENGINEER-IN-CHARGE:

You are requested to contact Senior Manager (MSP Operations), NRL who will be the EIC for this job for further instructions relating to execution of the work.

PAYMENT TERMS: Within 30 days after receipt of invoices complete in all sides.

Payment shall be made after successful completion of work based on certification made for payment by E-I-C.

CONTRACTUAL PERIOD:

The subject job shall be completed in 15 (Fifteen) days (Approx.) from the date of site handover excluding mobilization time. Mobilization includes manpower reaching at site, preparation for work and making everything ready for taking work permit. Thereafter execution of the job till hand over to operation shall not take more than 15 days. BID QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

The intending bidders for above tender should meet the qualifications as given below:
 Past Experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 10 years ending last month should be either of the following:

- Three similar completed works costing not less than **Rs. 29.69** Lakhs each, or
- > Two similar completed works costing not less than **Rs. 39.58** Lakhs each, or
- ➤ One similar completed work costing **Rs. 49.48** Lakhs.

*Similar Works: Bidder must have experience of at least 3 nos of similar job of catalyst replacement under inert nitrogen in refineries or other industries. Bidders must submit the reference list of earlier jobs (of similar nature) executed, with a copy of work order in support of the same, with the offer.

- Note: (i) The bidder must submit copy (ies) of relevant Work Order(s) and Completion Certificate(s) along with the unpriced bid in support of the above criteria. The value of past experience shall be adjusted at a simple rate of 07% for every completed year and/or part thereof
 - (ii) TDS certificate in addition to certificate issued by principal contractor/private organization (letter of award and job completion certificate etc.) shall from the basis for considering experience and value of work executed under the private organization.
- 2. Average Annual Turnover during last 3 years, ending 31st March of previous Financial Year: At least **Rs. 29.69 Lakhs.** The bidder must submit copy (ies) financial documents Trading and P/L account(s) certified by Chartered Accountant along with the un-priced bid in support of the above criteria.

SPECIAL NOTE TO THE BIDDERS:

• The relaxation of Prior Turnover and Prior Experience will not be applicable for "Micro and Small Enterprise (MSE)" and "Start-ups" bidders for the subject tender.

• OTHER REQUIREMENT:

It is to be noted that experience as main contractor will only be taken cognizance of for the purpose of assessing qualifying criteria. However, authorized sub-contractors under principal contractors can also be considered provided their works completion certificate is issued by the client organization in case of job executed elsewhere under PSUs, limited companies, Government Departments, Quasi government and autonomous bodies. However, in case of sub-contractors under contractors engaged by NRL, the works completion certificate issued by the main contractor will also be acceptable provided the same is endorsed in original by Engineer-in-charge of NRL in terms of job description and value.

For accepting experience as sub-contractor(s) or contractors under Private Organizations, in addition to the requisite certificates (letter of award and job completion certificate etc.)TDS certificate issued by principal contractor/private organization shall form the basis for considering experience and value of work executed.

- 3. Bidder should have following valid documents on the date of Closing of tender and copy of the same needs to be submitted along with the technical Bid:
 - i. Provident Fund Registration Number.
 - ii. ESI registration number.
 - iii. Income Tax PAN Number.
 - iv. GST Registration Number.

4. Bidders who are on holiday list by NRL or any other Oil sector PSU will not be considered. **Accordingly, the bidder shall submit a self declaration as per format enclosed with Tender Document.** It may be noted that if this declaration is found to be false, NRL shall have the right to reject bidder's offer, and if the bid has resulted in a contract, the contract is liable to be terminated.

Non fulfillment of all the above mention Technical & Commercial Qualifying criteria will lead to disqualification of bidder.

Offer will be considered only when NRL is satisfied with experience and capability of the tenderer to take up this work.

110.0 ARBITRATION:

<u>Arbitration Clause for PSEs / Govt. Deptt.</u> (except a dispute or difference concerning the Railways, incometax, Customs and Excise Duties),

"In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of the contracts, such dispute or difference shall be referred by either for Arbitration to the sole arbitrator in the Department of Public Enterprises to be nominated by the Secretary to the Government of India in-charge of the Department of Public Enterprises. The arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall not be applicable to Arbitration under this clause. The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

REGISTRATION
