Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

- 1. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
- 2. Data Sheet of the product(s) offered in the bid, are to be uploaded along with the bid documents. Buyers can match and verify the Data Sheet with the product specifications offered. In case of any unexplained mismatch of technical parameters, the bid is liable for rejection.
- 3. Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.
- 4. The bidder is required to upload, along with the bid, all relevant certificates such as BIS licence, type test certificate, approval certificates and other certificates as prescribed in the Product Specification given in the bid document.

- 11. In page no. 2 of ANNEXURE(Tech)-1, for SI. No. 80 (item code I-CABL-C06D-01) number of control c able pair shall be **6 pairs.**
- 22. On page 19 of ANNEXURE (Tech)-1, Thermocouple Compensating Cable specification (INST/SPEC/CA BLE/05) point number 41 EMF Tolerance (± ° C) shall be as per **IEC 60584-3.**
- 3. In the ANNEXURE(Tech)-1, Standard Specification for Signal Cables specifications (NRL/INST/SPEC/C ABLE/01) point numbers 9/27/35 "minimum thickness" shall be read as "nominal thickness" as per IS1554 Part I.
- 44. In the ANNEXURE(Tech)-1, Standard Specification for Signal Cables specifications (NRL/INST/SPEC/CABLE/02) point numbers 9/28/36 "minimum thickness" shall be read as "nominal thickness" as per IS1554 Part I.
- 5. **Item 4 & 5 of BOQ** refer to same technical specs item, i.e. **I-CABL-D01D-01** (Signal cable 1 Tria d 2.5 sq. mm armored Black) with different quantities for internal evaluation purposes. **As such, bi dders shall quote exact same rates for both items.**

Pre-qualification criteria (PQC):

- 1. The bidder shall be the manufacturer of the offered cables.
- 2. The bidder must have prior experience of Supplying Instrumentation Cables to any Hydrocarbon Refiner y/Petrochemical plants under Govt. of India during last 10 years (Ten) years ending last day of month previous to the one in which the original bid due date falls. Bidder shall provide following documents in support of this PQC.
- (a) Copy of Purchase order issued, directly by the End user or by EPCM on behalf of end user, in the name of the bidder for the "Supply of Instrumentation cables" in any Hydrocarbon Refinery/Petrochemical plant

under Govt. of India.

(b) Documentary evidence as proof of successful Job Completion. Copy of certificate/Material Entry Document/Tax Invoice etc. to substantiate the execution of the submitted order copy

Note: Relaxation of PTR to MSE/ Startup will not be applicable for this tender.

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Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

- 1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for <u>attached categories</u>, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
