Two parts bid **ONLINE (E-tender)** offers requested from competent contractors for following work:

Please note that EMD amount only in online mode is acceptable and no other mode i.e. offline or hard copy is not acceptable.) In case of MSE registered bidders- bidder has to upload the scanned copy of UAM/EM-Part-II certificate with the technical bid for EMD exemption
Contract Period:	02(Two) years with a provision for extension by another 01(One) year as per requirement of NRL

BRIEF SCOPE OF WORK: As per Tender Document, Technical tender Document, SCC and SOR.

PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

1. The bidder has to submit valid electrical supervisory licenses or agreement along with the offer.
2. **Past Experience** of having successfully completed similar works* during last 10 years ending last day of the month, proceeding the month in which bids are invited should be either of the following :-
 - One similar work costing not less than **Rs.37.41[#] Lakh** or
 - Two similar works costing not less than **Rs.29.93[#] Lakh** each or
 - Three similar completed works costing **Rs.22.45[#] Lakh** each

***Similar works:** Experience in executing jobs of :

A) Operation of any plant consisting motor driven pump or diesel engine driven generator.

Or,

B) Maintenance of pump or motors for plant operation and maintenance.

Bidder must have experience of executing similar jobs (i.e. Sl. No. A or B) in Indian PSUs or in other Govt. agencies. The bidder must submit copies of relevant Work orders and Job Completion Certificates indicating final executed value in support of this criterion along with unpriced bid.

[#] The Value of past experience be adjusted at a simple rate of 7% for every completed year and/ or part thereof ending last day of the month preceding the month in which bids are invited

Note: The bidder must submit copy (ies) of relevant Work Order(s) and Completion Certificate(s) along with the un-priced bid in support of the above criteria.

3. Average Annual Financial Turnover during the last three years ending 31st March of the previous financial year, shall be at least **Rs.22.45 Lakh**. The bidder must submit copy (ies) financial documents – Trading and P/L account(s) along with the un-priced bid in support of the above criteria.

Bidder should have following valid documents to be submitted along with the technical Bid on the date of Closing of tender.

- (i) Income Tax PAN number.
- (ii) GST registration number.
- (iii) PF & ESI certificate

SPECIAL NOTE TO BIDDERS:

- a) The relaxation of Prior Turnover and Prior Experience (Indicated in the tender document) will not be applicable for Micro and Small Enterprise (MSE) or Startup bidder for the subject tender as the job is critical in nature from refinery safety point. As such Pre-Qualifying Criteria mentioned in the tender document should be complied by all participating bidders.
- b) NRL adopts a practice to verify documents submitted by L1 (successful) bidder in support of bidder's credential against PQC. Authentication may be verified with the issuing authorities, by way of direct communication to NRL over official e-mail IDs / Original letter of authentication by post. Bidders may also follow up with the issuing authority for eliciting early response. If documents remain unauthenticated till given time line, NRL reserves the right to reject the bid.

Proper address of communication, including e-mail ID of the issuing authority should be provided along the tender document.

Non fulfillment of all the above mention Technical & Commercial Qualifying criteria will lead to disqualification of bidder.

The bidder shall be at liberty to be present either in person or through an authorized representative at the time of opening of the Technical Bid. Price Bids of only those bidders shall be opened who are Techno-commercially qualified, at a time and place for which notice shall be given. The qualified bidders shall be at liberty to be present either in person or through an authorized representative at the time of opening of the Price Bids with the Bid Acknowledgement Receipt. They can also view the bid opening event online at their remote end.

Procedure or Process for Online Submission of EMD:

- 1) User Manual for Bidders is available in NRL Website under <https://www.nrl.co.in> → Tenders → Tender Manual → EMD Online Deposit Manual (HDFC Bank Payment Portal)
- 2) Visit HDFC Bank Payment Portal URL: <https://nrl.procure247.com>
- 3) Click on 'Bidder Registration'
- 4) Bidder Registration Screen shall appear – Fill the mandatory details required and complete the process.
- 5) On successful submission of details in bidder registration form, bidder will get the system generated link to verify his/her email id and login to the website. Without verifying email id bidder may not be able to login to the system.
- 6) After successful email verification – please login with your user id and password
- 7) Bidder will receive system generate One Time Password (OTP) on their registered mobile number. In case not receiving of OTP please click Regenerate OTP and login.
- 8) After login Screen bidder can search the tenders and proceed for EMD payment.
- 9) Bidders' have to click on Payment Dashboard option available under Action tab
- 10) Payment Dashboard – Click on Pay to proceed further for the selection of payment mode.
- 11) Smart Hub – Bidders' can select the online payment and click on Pay to proceed further.
- 12) After click on Pay – Bidder will get an option for Cards and Net Banking. Bidders can select their preference and proceed further for the payment.
- 13) On successful payment bidder will receive system generated message on screen stating "EMD paid successfully"
- 14) Bidders' can also download the Payment receipt from Payment Dashboard.
- 15) Downloaded payment receipt – Bidders' can easily print the receipt and use it for their bidding purpose.
- 16) Since the HDFC Bank payment gateway is not under the CPPP, so the payment mode is mentioned as offline (BG) in the CPP portal. Bidder has to make a dummy entry in the EMD fields of CPPP by putting 'Transaction ID' (HDFC Bank payment receipt) as instrument no., payment date as issue date, any date as expiry date, and bank name as issuer details. Please upload the EMD payment receipt along with technical bid.
