- b. #### 4. HOLIDAY LISTING

Bidders who are on holiday list by NRL or any other Oil sector PSU will not be considered. Accordingly, the bidder shall submit a self-declaration as per format enclosed with Tender Document. It may be noted that if this declaration is found to be false, NRL shall have the right to reject bidder's offer, and if the bid has resulted in a contract, the contract is liable to be terminated.

## 5. PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (PQC):

Refer: Para 2 of Annexure A"SPECIAL CONDITION OF THE CONTRACT(SCC)".

Note-1: All bidder shall mandatorily meet PQC criteria.

<u>Note-2</u>: Along with unpriced offer, bidder shall furnish all relevant documents as proof of eligibility to qualify PQC of the bid, failing to which bidder is liable to be rejected during technical evaluation without any further communication.

### 6. PTR RELAXATION TO MSE/START UP:

The pre-qualification criteria (PQC) related to prior turnover and prior experience of the bidder will be relaxed if the bidder is Micro and Small Enterprise (MSE) or Start Up and meets the quality and technical specifications described in the tender, subject to submission of relevant supporting documents.

- Supporting documents for MSE bidders: UDYAM certificate.
- Supporting documents for Start-up: Bidder who intends to participate as 'Start-up' company should enclose the Certificate of Recognition issued by Department of Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Govt. of India.

#### Note:

a) Above supporting documents are required to be uploaded by bidder along with un-priced techno-commercial bid only. It is the responsibility of the bidder to upload the above supporting documents along with their un-priced techno-commercial bid for availing relaxation on Prior Turnover and Prior Experience (if applicable in this tender). In case of non-receipt of above documents along with bidder's un-priced bid, no further communication in this regard will be carried out to ascertain

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bidder's qualification as 'MSE bidder/ Start-up' and relaxation on Prior Turnover and Prior Experience (if applicable in this tender) will not be passed on to bidder.

#### 7. PRICED EVALUATION CRITERIA OF THE TENDER:

Priced Evaluation of the techno-commercially accepted offers shall be done on "Overall Lowest offer basis". Item is **NOT SPLITABLE.** 

Note to all bidders: Comparison shall be made against the final Landing Costs at delivery Sites (including all other applicable charges like P & F, Transportation charge, Transit Insurance etc.-as mentioned in BOQ)

Price basis 'Free on road (FOR)' to respective delivery sites.

# 8. TENDERS FROM MICRO AND SMALL ENTERPRISES (MSEs):

Purchase preference to Indian MSEs (Micro & Small Enterprises) shall be applicable as per Govt. of India policies. Refer details in Annexure-X.

# 9. PURCHASE PREFERENCE POLICY LINKED WITH LOCAL CONTENT (PP-LC):

MOP & NG has notified the purchase preference (linked with local content) for the procurement of goods and services under Oil & Gas projects in India. #### 13. PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE (PBG):

Submission of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) for 10% of the value of the first year of the contract. PBG may be submitted for each location separately or combined. PBG shall be valid for 1 year from the first "Zero Date" of the first year with an additional 6 months claim period. PBG must be renewed (or new PBG submitted) for second and third year of the contract. In case, PBG is not provided by the vendor, 10% of the basic value shall be retained in lieu of PBG, till the expiry of BG period.

Suppliers/Contractors are required to submit their BGs strictly as per the said standard format(s) only. If any bidder desires to make any changes to the standard format(s), same should be clearly indicated in their bid itself for acceptance of NRL during the techno-commercial evaluation stage. Decision for acceptance or refusal of any request for change by NRL shall be at the sole discretion of NRL. No change request after acceptance of bid may be allowed.

BG shall be valid for: Contractual Delivery Date (CDD) + Warranty Period + Claim period of 6 months.

In case of delay in delivery/completion and/or extension of CDD/CCD, the validity of the BG should be extended by the Supplier/Contractor prior to expiry of the original validity period. Pending such timely extension, suit or action to enforce a claim under Guarantee may be initiated by NRL.

#### 14. GENERAL:

- (i) NRL adopts a practice to verify documents submitted by L1 (successful) bidder in support of bidder's credential against PQC. Authentication may be verified with the issuing authorities, by way of direct communication to NRL over official e-mail IDs / Original letter of authentication by post. Bidders may also follow up with the issuing authority to elicit an early response. If documents remain unauthenticated till the given timeline, NRL reserves the right to reject the bid. A proper address for communication, including e-mail ID of the issuing authority should be provided along the tender document.
- (ii) The offer will be considered only when NRL is satisfied with the experience and capability of the tenderer to take up this work.
- (iii) Canvassing in any other form by the bidder or by any other agency on their behalf may lead to disqualification of their bid.
- (iv) In case any of the document/information(s) furnished by a bidder are found to be false/forged, such bidder shall be kept in holiday list/ blacklist apart from other penal actions as deemed fit by NRL.
- (v) In case any bidder is found to be involved cartel formation, his bid will not be considered for evaluation/placement of order. Such bidder will also be debarred from bidding in future.
- (vi) Govt. has reduced the aggregate turnover for applicability of E-invoices from earlier limit Rs.20 crores to Rs. 10 crores, which will be effective from 1st Oct'2022. In view above, all concerns are requested to raise only E-invoice to NRL with all requisite details like IRN, QR code etc. Non-complied invoices shall not be accepted for further processing.
