NRL hereby invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from Indian/Global Company/their Consortium/Affiliates/JV/Representatives, herein after called "Applicant", for Setting up a Carbon Monoxide Plant by using SMR (Steam methane reforming) gas as feed from NRL's Hydrogen Unit, at Numaligarh.

Applicant shall submit response to the EOI, completed in all respect along with all documents on the CPP portal, on or before the last date of submission i.e. 03.07.2025 (Thursday).

The objective of this EOI is to identify and obtain the details of the prospective Applicants including their experience and financial capabilities for setting up of the Carbon Monoxide Plant from SMR Gas of Hydrogen Unit, on Built Own and Operate (BOO) or Job Work basis.

2. Particulars of the EOI

1. Introduction

- 1.1 Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL) is a Government of India Enterprise, located at Numaligarh, Dist. Golaghat, in Assam India NRL is a group company of Oil India Limited and is a Category-I Mini Ratna PSU
- 1.2 The current refining capacity of NRL is 3 MMTPA and the complex comprises of process units like CDU/VDU, DCU, HCU, HGU, MS Block, DHDT, SRU and Wax Block Units along with its own CPP (GTG+STG) and other utilities. The commercial production commenced from 1st October, 2000. Product slate of NRL comprises LPG, BS-VI HSD, BS-VI MS, ATF, SKO, MTO, Paraffin Wax, RPC/CPC (Raw/Calcined Petroleum Coke) and Sulphur. NRL has two marketing terminals at Numaligarh and Siliguri. Products viz. MS, SKO and HSD are transported from Numaligarh to Siliguri through the Product pipeline (NSPL) owned & operated by Oil India Limited.
- 1.3 NRL is currently pursuing the Refinery Expansion Project (NREP) for increase the refining capacity from 3.0 to 9.0 MMTPA by setting up a new train of 6.0 MMTPA, along with Crude oil pipeline from Paradip, Odisha to Numaligarh, Assam and a Crude Oil Import Terminal at Paradip, Odisha. The ongoing NREP is target to be completed by December 2025.
- 1.4 The hydrogen requirement of the existing refinery is met from the Hydrogen Generation Unit (HGU) of capacity 48 KTPA (67412 Nm3/hr), which is licensed by M/s Topsoe. Demand of H2 for expansion project (NREP) shall be met by a 95 KTPA HGU, which is being set up under the BOO (Build, Own &Operate) mode. NRL has also taken initiatives to set up Green Hydrogen plants of total capacity 12.4KTPA at Numaligarh, in line with country's target to achieve net zero by 2070.
- 1.5 It is expected that the capacity of existing HGU may not be fully utilized in view of projected decline in demand of fossil fuel HSD & MS as well as due to availability of more H2 from the new Green H2 plants. Therefore, to utilize the maximum capacity of HGU, it is intended to repurpose the existing hydrogen unit to produce Carbon monoxide (CO) by using SMR gas (u/s of shift reactor) of HGU and also to capture CO2.

2. The intent of EOI

- 2.1 NRL desires that a CO production plant can be set up to produce CO from SMR Gas of Hydrogen Unit. The plant to be setup on Build Own Operate (BOO) / Job Work basis.
- 2.2 NRL has issued this Expression of Interest with the best intention to explore the market for interested Entities/Agencies who are interested and eligible to enter into long term agreement with NRL (minimum 20 years) for setting up of Carbon Monoxide Production Plant from SMR Gas of Hydrogen Unit. The Purpose of the EOI is not to select any agency/ entity for the proposed project or for shortlisting for any tender.

- 2.3 NRL invites "Expression of Interest" (EOI) for the sole purpose of seeking information from prospective Applicants about their technical and financial capabilities for setting up of the plant including operating the unit for specific period.
- 2.4 The Applicant should be willing to share their past credentials for evaluation. Requisite Non-Disclosure Agreement shall be executed as deemed essential by the Applicant.
- 2.5 The estimated quantity of CO production is about 270TPD from the available SMR gas. Setting up of CO plant will require a CO2 separation unit.

Note: This is not an invitation to tender.

3. Brief scope of Work / Services:

The brief scope of the Applicant under this project shall include but not limited to following:

- 3.1 Applicant is solely responsible for setting up the CO production plant by taking SMR feed from HGU B/L & Utilities, from NRL
- 3.2 The piping works for routing the feed & utilities from NRL B/L to the Applicant's site is under Applicant's scope.
- 3.3 The piping works for the H2 rich gas and CH4 rich gas from CO cold box to be laid by Applicant up to NRL's B/L.
- 3.4 Applicant has to take necessary statutory clearances from government authorities for setting up the plant.
- 3.5 Applicant to select suitable technology for CO2 removal and CO production.
- 3.6 To carryout BEDP & detail engg, procurement, erection, commissioning and operation, thereafter.
- 3.7 To supply CO & CO2 as per the quality mentioned above at Applicants's B/L.

4. NRL's responsibility:

Following facilities shall be extended by NRL for this project :

- 4.1 To provide the required land to the bidder for setting up the CO plant. The tentative location of the plant will be inside NRL's plant boundary, which is about 3 km (Aerial) from the existing hydrogen unit.
- 4.2 To provide the SMR feed at HGU B/L, as mentioned above.
- 4.3 To supply utilities like power, water, instrument air, steam, N2 etc.
- 4.4 The modification required inside the existing Hydrogen unit to supply SMR gas.

5. Statutory Obligations

The Applicant has to ensure that all facilities to be constructed shall comply with the Rules and regulations applicable in Oil & Gas Industries, as per authorities of Govt. of India.

6. Time Schedule:

The tentative schedule planned for the project shall be as below:

- 6.1 Time Period for the Applicant to develop the facility: 24 (Twenty-four) Months form the date of issue of Letter of Acceptance).
- 6.2 The Applicant shall Operate and maintain the facilities for a minimum period of 20 (Twenty)

Years after Contractual COD or actual COD, whichever is later.
