1.0 INTRODUCTION

M/s Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL) is a Government of India Enterprise operates a 3.0 MMTPA Refinery at Numaligarh in the District of Golaghat, Assam since the year 2000.NRL is now in the process of executing a major expansion project of capacity augmentation from present 3.0 MMTPA to 9.0 MMTPA.

NRL is setting up 6 MMTPA Crude Oil Import terminal (COIT) at Paradip. The required additional quantity of crude oil is planned to be imported through IOCL Crude oil Terminal to NRL's Crude Oil Import terminal (COIT) in Odisha. A 50 inch size inter connecting pipeline shall be laid from IOCL COT to NRL's COIT Paradip. A 26 inch size cross country pipeline of around 1630 km shall be laid from NRL's COIT to Numaligarh refinery for transporting 8 MMTPA of imported crude oil.

The above-mentioned pipelines also include Despatch Terminal (DT) at existing terminal of IOCL refinery (IOCL-Paradip) & Receipt Terminal (RT) at NRL COIT Paradip for 50" pipeline and DT at NRL COIT Paradip, four (4) nos. Intermediate Pigging Station (IPS), three (3) nos. Intermediate Pigging cum Pumping Station (IPPS) & RT at Numaligarh for 26" pipeline.

Engineers India Ltd (EIL) is the EPCM Consultant of NRL for the above Project and EIL on behalf of NRL is authorized to enter into correspondence / discussions & obtain any clarification and confirmations from the bidder. Accordingly, EIL on behalf of NRL invites bids executing the subject tender.

2.0 BRIEF SCOPE WORKS

2.1 This composite works tender scope envisaged for the facilities coming at DT at IOCL COT (50 "Inch Pipeline) and RT (50 Inch Pipeline), DT (26 Inch Pipeline) & other Pump Sheds at NRL's COIT Paradip.

The scope of work covers the terminal works as per following:

- Despatch Terminal (DT) for 50" pipeline and associated facilities including one (01 no.) hook-up by hot tapping & one (01 no.) hook-up by cold cutting at existing facilities of IOCL-Paradip.
- Receipt Terminal (RT) for 50" pipeline and associated facilities at COIT-Paradip.
- Despatch Terminal for 26" pipeline and associated facilities at COIT-Paradip.





- Installation of piping and associated facilities, mainline pumps, corrosion inhibitor (CI) dosing system, metering assemblies, sump tanks & sump pumps, Corrosion Monitoring System (CMS), scraper traps, Insulating Joints (IJs), Flow-Tees, strainers, LR bend, manual and actuated valves including Surge Relief Valve (SRV) & control valve, Hook-up by hot tapping method, Hook-up by cold cutting method etc.
- Entire civil and structural, electrical activities in all respect pertaining to Mainline Pump House, Booster Pump House, Instrument Air Compressor Shed, Demulsifier Skid Shed, Under Ground Sump Pits.
- RCC Piles works
- Installation of Electrical Switchboards and termination of Cables at COIT.
- Supply and Installation, Commissioning of Fire Alarm System for Various building at NRL COIT.
- Calibration and Installation of the Field Instruments.
- Supply and laying of Instruments cables.
- Termination of Control and Signal cables and Installation of PLC system.
- All Equipment foundations and Piping Supports.
- Fire water Piping System.
- Supply, Installation and Commissioning of Sump pumps and CI Dosing System.
- Installation of Mainline Pump, Booster Pump, UG Vessel, Filter, Instrument Compressor Package, Surge relief skid, Demulisfirer Skid.
- Cathodic Protection for UG vessels
- Pre commissioning and Commissioning Assistance.
- 2.2 The brief scope of work also includes supply, installation & testing of Bored cast-in situ straight shaft RCC pile.

Pile details

a) Type of pile : Bored cast-in situ straight shaft RCC pile

b) Diameter of pile : 500 mm

c) Length of pile : 25 m (Approx.) below cut-off level (Pile Type-I)

13 m (Approx.) below cut-off level (Pile Type-II)

d) Number of piles : 420 Nos. (Pile Type-I)

80 Nos. (Pile Type-II)

Carrying out initial pile load tests on the test piles specially installed for the purpose, routine pile load tests and low strain integrity test on job piles selected randomly by the Engineer-in-charge.

3.0 COMPLETION PERIOD:

Mechanical Completion and making the system ready for Pre-commissioning within 16 (Sixteen) Months from the date of issue of Letter of Acceptance plus 1 (one) Month for assistance for Pre-Commissioning and Commissioning.

Mechanical Completion means signing of "Format-III (READY FOR PRE-COMMISSIONING CERTIFICATE)" by OWNER.

5.0 BIDDER QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (BQC):

The Bidder shall meet the following criteria-

5.1 COMMERCIAL EXPERIENCE CRITERIA:

The Bidder should have completed in last 10 (Ten) years ending last date of month previous to one in which bids are invited, at least One or Two or Three Contracts of works for the value not less than as mentioned below:

A. The Bidder should have completed Mechanical Work in Hydrocarbon sector (Refineries, Petrochemical complex, Receiving Terminal / Dispatch Terminal / Marketing Terminal / Intermediate Pumping Stations/ Gas Processing-On shore) / Fertilizer Sector of value not less than —

 Mechanical Works means Mechanical works involving piping and/or equipment erection work in Hydrocarbon sector (Refineries, Petrochemical complex, Receiving Terminal / Dispatch Terminal / Marketing Terminal / Intermediate Pumping Stations/ Gas Processing-On shore) / Fertilizer Sector.

Note:

ii. If the Past Reference submitted by Bidder includes equipment Supply component more than 30% of Total Completed value, then the value of the supply component exceeding 30% of the total Completed value of respective Past Experience shall not be considered for Bid Qualification purpose.

If the Past Reference submitted by Bidder includes equipment Supply component less than or equal to 30% of Completed value, the Completed value of Past Experience shall be considered for Bid Qualification purpose.

iii. The works carried out by Bidder for Mounded Bullets, Spheres, Storage Tanks, Cross Country Pipeline Laying Works, shall not be considered as relevant experience to meet the experience criteria under Mechanical Works.

In case the Past Experience submitted by Bidder includes Terminal Works (as specified above) and Cross Country Pipeline Laying Works, only the value of Terminal Works (as specified above) shall be considered for Evaluation. Bidder shall submit documentary evidence for the same.

AND

B. Electrical Works:

In addition to above, if bidder is meeting experience criteria mentioned against (A), the bidder shall also meet the following experience criteria of Electrical Works:

Civil Works means Civil works in an Industrial Plant or in Hydrocarbon sector (Refineries, Petrochemical complex, Receiving Terminal / Despatch Terminal / Marketing Terminal/ Intermediate Pumping Stations/ Gas Processing-On shore) / Fertilizer Sector.

Note to (B) & (C) above:

In case the Bidder does not meet the requirement indicated at clause no. (B) & (C) by their own but meet the requirements of clause no. (A) indicated above, they can engage one or more suitable sub-contractor (having experience of execution of Electrical Work and/or Civil Works and meeting the requirement as indicated at clause (B) & (C) above) so that total requirement stated at clause (A), (B) & (C) is met by the bidder along with their subcontractor/s.

Note for above mentioned Commercial BOC / Experience Criteria:

- i. Wherever bidder is getting qualified based on the credentials of sub-contractor, they must submit MOUalong with their bid in addition to the documents of Sub contractor as per clause no. 5.4.1.2 to 5.1.4.3. There shall be no change in MOU with sub-contractor after award of job.
- ii. The sub-contractor shall not be permitted to participate in the bidding process in an individual capacity as 'a bidder'.
- iii. A subcontractor to one bidder can be sub-contractor to other bidder (s) also.
- iv. The value of "similar work" shall be escalated at a simple rate of 7% for every completed year and thereafter at @ 0.58% for every completed month ending last day of the month preceding the month in which bids are invited.
- v. In case bidder has executed a Composite Work which included the qualifying works (s) as per the above definition of similar work, the value of such qualifying work (s) out of the total value of Composite work shall be considered for the purpose of qualification.





- vi. The value of experience in multidisciplinary work as stated above can either in a single contract or in multiple contracts.
- vii. Industrial Plant means any premises, in any part of which, a manufacturing or production process is being carried out or ordinarily so carried on.
- viii. In case, two separate Bidders submit reference of same work (wherein one was Main Contractor and the other was Sub-Contractor), both Bidders' experience shall be considered for qualification subject to Bidder's meeting other qualification requirements.
- ix. In case a Bidder submits PTR having job awarded for multiple Parts in single Work Order having separate completion schedule for each Part, and the Bidder wants to get qualified based on the completion of One or more Parts (irrespective of whether all Parts under the same work order are completed or not), which meets the subject BQC value-wise and with respect to Similar Work, the same may be considered subject to the completion certificate with executed value of that/those Part(s) from the Owner/End User/PMC for that/those Part(s).

However, where multiple-parts work is awarded under different Work Order(s) having different Work Order reference number(s) with the same Enquiry Document No., cumulative value of such completed Work Orders meeting definition of Similar Work, as submitted, shall be considered for the purpose of BQC Evaluation.

5.2 TECHNICAL CRITERIA:

In addition to Commercial Experience Criteria at clause no 5.1 above, Bidder shall also meet the following Technical Criteria:

- i. Bidder on his own should have executed and completed Bored cast in-situ straight shaft RCC piles of diameter 400mm or above of total length as per the following criteria during last ten (10) years ending last day of the month previous to one in which applications are invited.
 - a) One completed contract involving total piling not less than 2350 Meters.
- ii. Bidder's past experience as a leader or member of a Consortium/JV shall be considered acceptable provided his scope in that Consortium/JV meets the requirement stipulated in the subject BQC under evaluation.
- iii. In case bidder does not fulfil the criteria as per Clause 5.2 (i), bidder may engage subcontractor having requisite experience i.e., subcontractor on his own should have executed and completed Bored cast in-situ straight shaft RCC piles of diameter 400 mm or above of total length as per the criteria given in Clause 5.2 (i).
- iv. In case the bidder is getting qualified based on the experience of subcontractor, bidder shall not be permitted to change the subcontractor in the event contract is awarded to them. The bidder shall submitthe MOU with subcontractor and requisite documentary evidence as given in IFB Document. This agreement/ MOU/ Letter of Consent must remain in force at least till the pendency of the contract.
- v. A job completed by a Bidder as a subcontractor shall be considered for the purpose of meeting the experience criteria of BQC, provided the appointment of subcontractor was authorized and subject to submission of documents as listed in IFB Document in support of meeting the "Bidder's Qualification Criteria".





vi. Experience of only the Bidding entity shall be considered. A job executed by a Bidder for its own plant/projects shall not be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting the Qualification Criteria of the Enquiry document.

However, Jobs executed for Subsidiary/ Fellow Subsidiary / Holding company shall be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting BQC, subject to submission of documents required as per IFB document.

5.3 FINANCIAL CRITERIA:

Bidder shall meet the following criteria as per the Financial Statements audited and issued on or before Bid Due Date (Final Bid Due Date after extension, if any) –

5.3.1 Annual Turnover:

The minimum average annual turnover during three preceding financial years of the bidder as per the audited annual financial results shall be ₹ 19.19 Crore.

5.3.2 Net Worth

The financial net-worth of the Bidder as per the immediate proceeding year's audited annual financial results shall be positive.

Further, negative Net worth shall not be rejection criteria for CPSEs. Contract award shall be purely on competitive basis and CPSEs having negative Net worth shall furnish an undertaking in their Bid that performance shall not be compromised.

5.3.3 CALCULATION OF TURNOVER AND NET WORTH

a) Net worth calculation:

Net worth means paid up share capital, Share Application Money pending allotment* and reserves# *less* accumulated losses and deferred expenditure to the extent not written off. Net worth shall be calculated using the following formula:

Reserves to be considered for the purpose of net worth shall be all **reserves created out of**the profits and securities premium account but shall not include reserves created out of
revaluation of assets, write back of depreciation and amalgamation.

*Share Application Money pending allotment will be considered only in respect of share to be allotted.

b) **Turnover (for the Financial Statement pertaining to post GST regime):** Turnover shall be calculated excluding GST and other Incomes.

[**Note:** If the financial Statements is prior to implementation of GST, and the Excise Duty is shown extra in the Financial Statement, the Turnover shall be inclusive of Excise Duty but excluding other income]

5.3.4 Financial years/ previous period as above shall be reckoned from the due date ending on the last day of the month immediately preceding the month in which the last date of bid submission falls.

5.4 DOCUMENTS AND DATA REQUIRED WITH BID

- **5.4.1. Documents towards Commercial Experience Criteria:**
- 5.4.1.1 The bidder [and/or their proposed subcontractor] shall, in his own interest, furnish complete documentary evidence to justify that the bidder meets the Commercial Experience Qualification Criteria as given above.
- 5.4.1.2 Copies of Work order, Completion certificate from Owner/ End User / PMC etc. in the name of the Bidder meeting requirements as laid in clause no 5.1.
- 5.4.1.3 Bidder [and/or their proposed subcontractor] shall submit documentary proof such as Scope of works/specification/survey reports/drawings (for Similar Works)/Invoices/Final Bill or any other documentary evidence to substantiate the executed value of similar work and to establish the Similar Work as defined in clause no 5.1 correlating the work order and completion certificate.
- 5.4.1.4 Bidder [and/or their proposed subcontractor] shall submit documentary evidence along with declaration regarding value of supply portion in submitted PTR.
 - 5.4.2. **Documents required with bid for Technical Criteria**:
- 5.4.2.1 The bidder shall, in his own interest, furnish complete documentary evidence to justify that the bidder meets the Qualification Criteria as given above.

The documents to be furnished should include the following:

- a) Work order of Bored cast in-situ straight shaft RCC piling works mentioning the quantity and the scope of work, certified copy of final RA bill as documentary evidence.
- b) Documentary evidence of successful completion of Bored cast in-situ straight shaft RCC piling works from the client/ main contractor. Completion certificate shall contain volume of work in terms of total length indicating diameter and length of pile installed.





- 5.4.2.2 In case bidder has worked as a leader or member of a Consortium/JV, in addition to documents as given in Clause 5.4.2.1, the bidder shall submit Scope matrix clearly mentioning the quantum of work to meet the Bidder qualification criteria.
- 5.4.2.3 In case the bidder along with subcontractor qualifies as per the criteria given in Clause 5.2 (iii), the bidder shall submit the Memorandum of understanding (MOU) / Agreement / Letter of Consent between bidder and subcontractor and requisite documentary evidence as given in Clause 5.4.2.1.
 - 5.4.2.4 Whenever a contractor had worked as a subcontractor to main contractor, with regard to subcontracted work order, in addition to documents as given in Clause 5.4.2.1, the bidder has to submit the following:
 - a) Documentary evidence/Certificate by the end-User/Owner/PMC, with regards to approval of Bidder/ engaging Bidder/ execution by the Bidder as a subcontractor to the Main Contractor.
 - b) Work order and Completion Certificates indicating the value of works and date of completion issued by Main Contractor (including SOR, wherever required for establishing scope of work
- 5.4.2.5 Bidder shall submit "Experience Record Proforma" for past piling experience as per format given in Annexure-I.

5.4.3. Documents towards Financial Criteria:

- (i) Complete **Audited Financial Statement** (which includes 'Balance Sheet' and 'Profit & Loss Account' along-with the all schedules, Notes referred to therein and the Auditor's report) audited and issued on or before bid due date for preceding **Three (3) Financial Years**.
- (ii) Bidders to submit copies of audited profit & loss account for the last Three financial years in support of annual turnovers "or" certification of annual turnovers for the last three financial years from a registered chartered accountant firm. Last Three financial years mentioned above refers to immediate 3 preceding financial years wherever the last bid submission date is after 30th Sept. In case of tenders having last bid submission date up to 30th September, and audited / CA certified turnover documents of the preceding financial year is not available, the audited / CA certified turnover documents of the 3 years prior to preceding financial year will be considered.

Notes towards Financial Documentation:

- a) Bidder shall submit Standalone Financial Statements. However, Consolidated Audited Financial Statements are acceptable in following situations:
- (i) **Bidder is a Parent/Holding Company:** Where only consolidated Audited Financial Statements are prepared and audited, which includes the financial details of their wholly owned subsidiaries etc., consolidated audited financial statement shall be considered for establishing the financial criteria subject to Statutory Auditor certifying that standalone Financial Statements of Bidder (without the financial data of subsidiaries, etc.) is not separately prepared and audited.
- (ii) **Bidder is a Subsidiary Company:** In case a Bidder is a Subsidiary Company and separate Financial Statements of the Bidder is not prepared & audited, but only a consolidated audited Financial Statements of their Parent Company/Holding Company are available, consolidated





audited Financial Statement shall be considered for establishing the financial criteria subject to Statutory Auditor of the Parent/Holding company (whose Audited Financial Statements are submitted for qualification) certifying in their letterhead that Financial Statements of Bidder are not separately prepared and audited.

- (iii) Annual Financial details shall have to be submitted along with the original offer within the bid due date. The Financial details submitted after bid due date will not be considered for evaluation, however, any missing document (issued prior to the bid due date) pertaining to the details furnished in the offer shall be allowed for submission.
- 5.5 Bidder [and/or their proposed subcontractor] should have minimum prescribed domestic value addition requirement in line with the Domestically Manufactured Iron & Steel Policy (DMI&SP) for the Iron & Steel products involved in execution of the contract. Bidder shall submit affidavit from the domestic manufacturers of such Iron & Steel products as per the Format enclosed in ANNEXURE 4 to ITB with the policy document.

A bidder who is not manufacturer of Iron & Steel products and is unable to submit the affidavit from domestic manufacturers at bidding stage, such bidder can submit the affidavit issued by domestic manufacturers after placement of order. In this case bidder along with his bid shall submit an undertaking as per attached as **Appendix-C** to this IFB.

If a bidder does not submit above affidavit or undertaking as per format, the offer of bidder shall be rejected.

5.6 Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN):

Bidder shall ensure that the certificate/reports issued/attested by practicing Chartered Accountant (CA)/Statutory Auditor in India shall contain Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) of the CA, without which these Certificates/ reports shall not be considered for evaluation.

However, this requirement of including UDIN shall not be applicable for certificate/reports issued/attested by a CA practicing in foreign country.

5.7 Authentication of BQC documents:

a) It is Bidder's prime responsibility to submit genuine and authentic documents. No amount of checking or verification by EIL/NRL shall absolve Bidder from his responsibility.

All documents furnished by the bidder in support of meeting the Bidder's Qualification Criteria (BQC) shall be:

Submitted duly certified by Statutory Auditor of the bidder or a practicing Chartered Accountant (not being an employee or a Director and not having any interest in the bidder's company) where audited accounts are not mandatory as per law.

OR

Submit documents duly notarized by any notary public in the bidder's country or certified true copies duly signed, dated and stamped by an official authorized for this purpose in Indian Embassy/ High Commission in Bidder's country."

OR

Bidder shall submit self-certified documents from any one out of CEO or CFO or Company Secretary of the bidder (Limited company only) along with Self- Certification as per Appendix-A to IFB [Format-





A]. In addition to above, Bidder shall furnish an undertaking in the format enclosed herewith as per Annexure-B to IFB [Format-B], from the same authority (authorities) who had signed and authenticated the documents.

OR

In case of PSU, the Power of Attorney holder duly authorized by the Board shall self-certify the BQC documents.

b) Bidder shall upload the authenticated copies of documents duly digitally signed, on the e-procurement website. Hence submission of physical document is not required.

Submission of authentic documents shall be the prime responsibility of the bidder. Wherever Consultant/ NRL has concern or apprehension regarding the authenticity/ correctness of any document, Consultant/NRL reserves the right to get the documents verified from issuing authority/any relevant source. If documents (part or full) are found forged, such offers will be summarily rejected, EMD will be forfeited, orders if any placed against subject tender will be terminated and may be debarred from future tenders. For the purpose of verification bidders shall submit complete client details with names, address, phone number, e-mail ID etc.

It shall, therefore, be responsibility of the bidder/ contractor to get their BQC documents considered for qualification successfully verified as above. Bidders may also follow up with the issuing authority for eliciting early response. If documents remain unauthenticated till given time line, NRL reserves the right to reject the bid.

Accordingly, bidder shall ensure that they submit those executed works meeting the qualification criteria for which they can arrange such verification.

The documents submitted by L1 bidder in support of their credentials against BQC shall be mandatorily verified with the issuing authorities.

5.8 OTHER POINTS:

5.8.1 Bidder's past experience as Consortium/Unincorporated Joint Venture (JV):

While evaluating the Bids, Bidder's [and/or their proposed subcontractor] past experience as a leader or member of a Consortium/Unincorporated Joint Venture (JV) shall be considered acceptable, provided his scope in that Consortium/JV meets the requirement stipulated in the subject BQC under evaluation.

In case, the PTR of Consortium/ Unincorporated Joint Venture (JV) experience submitted by the Bidder meets the similar work without indicating the division of scope of work in terms of specific activities and associated value of work between the Consortium/ Unincorporated Joint Venture (JV) members, but only the division of scope in terms of percentage share is indicated, in such case the completed value shall be arrived at after considering percentage share of each member, for the purpose of BQC evaluation.

5.8.2 Experience of Bidder [and/or their proposed sub-contractor] as a Sub-Contractor:

A job completed by a Bidder [and/or their proposed sub-contractor] as a Sub-Contractor shall be considered for the purpose of meeting the experience criteria of BQC, provided the appointment of Sub-Contractor was authorized and subject to submission of following documents in support of meeting the "Bidder's Qualification Criteria":





- a) Documentary evidence/Certificate by the end-User/Owner/PMC, with regards to approval of Bidder/ engaging Bidder/ execution by the Bidder as a Sub-Contractor to the Main Contractor
- b) Work order and Completion Certificates indicating the value of works and date of completion issued by Main Contractor (including SOR, wherever required for establishing scope of work).
- c) Submission Income Tax Return 23AS evidencing receipt of payment from the principal contractor.

5.8.3 Experience of Own Projects:

Experience of only the Bidding entity shall be considered. A job executed by a Bidder for its own plant/projects shall not be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting the Qualification Criteria of the Enquiry document.

However, Jobs executed for Subsidiary/ Fellow Subsidiary / Holding company shall be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting BQC, subject to submission of additional document towards "tax paid invoice(s) duly certified by Statutory Auditor of the Bidder or consolidated statement issued by Statutory Auditor of the Bidder towards payments of statutory tax" in support of the job executed for Subsidiary/ Fellow subsidiary / Holding company.

In case referred Project falls under "No Tax Area" (like SEZ), Bidder can submit certificate from their Statutory Auditor to this effect in place of Tax paid invoice.

Chartered Accountant (CA) (in place of Statutory Auditor) is acceptable where audited accounts are not mandatory as per law for latest financial year. Also CA shall not be an employee/ Director and not having any interest in the Bidder's company/Firm.

5.9 Notwithstanding any other condition/ provision in the tender documents, bidders are required to submit complete documents pertaining to BQC along with their offer. Failure to meet the BQC will render the bid to be summarily rejected. EIL/NRL reserves the right to complete the evaluation based on the details furnished by the bidder, with or without seeking any additional supporting documents /clarifications.

6.0 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD) / BID SECURITY;

- **6.1** Bids must be accompanied with Earnest Money Deposit / Bid Security as per proforma enclosed in GCC of value of INR 1,81,22,000.00 (Indian Rupees One Crore Eighty-One Lakh Twenty Two Thousand only).
- 6.2 Bids not accompanied with requisite Earnest Money deposit / Bid Security shall be considered as non-responsive and such Bids shall be summarily rejected.
- 6.3 Bidder must submit original EMD in a sealed envelope to Tender issuing Authority (instructions and address mentioned in ITB) within bid due date time and upload a scan copy of EMD or proof of submission of online EMD on e-Tendering Website. The procedure for online submission of EMD shall be as per ITB.
- 6.4 In case bidder makes online payment towards EMD but fails to upload the scanned copy of proof of online EMD submission their bid shall not be considered for evaluation.
- 6.5 In case the bidder fails to submit the original EMD within bid due date and time, then their bid shall be rejected irrespective of the fact that a copy of EMD / proof of EMD submission was earlier uploaded by the bidder.





- 6.6 EMD exemption shall be applicable for Micro or Small Enterprises registered with Udyam Registration as per The Gazette of India notification of Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise. The certificate issued should be valid on the date of opening of unpriced bid.
- 6.7 There will be no waiver of EMD for Public Sector undertakings of Central or State governments.
- 6.8 For further clarification refer of ITB for further details.

7.0 **GENERAL**

- 7.1 Unincorporated Joint Venture (JV) / Consortium Bids shall not be accepted.
- 7.2 Bidders should have valid PF, ESI, GST Registration and PAN.
- 7.3 Provision for procurement from bidders from country(ies) sharing land border with India: Bidder shall confirm compliance as per provisions of Instructions to Bidders (ITB).
- 7.4 Owner/EIL reserves the right to evaluate the Bids using in-house information.
- 7.5 Bidder [and/or their proposed sub-contractor] should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings.
- 7.6 Bidders and their proposed subcontractor (if any) who are on holiday list of EIL/NRL and/or MoPNG shall not be considered for evaluation.
- 7.7 NRL / EIL shall not be responsible or liable for cost incurred in preparation, submission & delivery of Bids, site visit, participating in the discussion and other expenses incurred during the Bidding process, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Bidding process.
- 7.8 In case, any Bidder [and/or their proposed sub-contractor] is found to be involved in cartel formation, their Bid shall not be considered for evaluation/placement of order. Such Bidder [and/or their proposed sub-contractor] shall be put on Holiday / blacklisted / debarred from Bidding in future for NRL / EIL.
- 7.9 Canvassing in any form by the Bidder or by any other agency on their behalf may lead to disqualification of their Bid.
- 7.10 NRL / EIL reserves the right to reject any/or all the Bids received or annul the Bidding process at any time at their sole discretion without assigning any reason thereof.
- 7.11 Unsolicited clarifications to the offer and/ or change in the prices during the validity period would render the bid liable for rejection.
- 7.12 Class I and Class II suppliers are eligible to quote for this tender. Purchase preference as per Make In India policy shall be applicable for Class I bidders only. However, if Reverse Auction is conducted, no Purchase Preference shall be resorted.
- 7.13 Purchase preference for MSE bidders shall not be applicable for this tender.
- 7.14 BQC relaxation to start ups and MSE bidders shall not be applicable.
- 7.15 Owner / EIL reserve the right to complete evaluation of the bidder as per the details furnished by bidder without seeking any additional information / document.
- 7.16 For terms and conditions and other details/Specifications, refer complete Bidding document and subsequent Amendment(s), if any.
