2. **SUBMISSION OF E-BID**:

The E-Bid should be prepared in Two Parts as per the following details.

i) PART – I: Techno-commercial / Unpriced Bid

ii) PART - II : Price Bid

Note:

- ii) This Tender is being conducted in e-tendering mode and the Bid documents can be downloaded for ONLINE bidding by the bidders, who has the Digital Signature Certificates.

- iv) Bids received by way of Post, Courier, Fax, Telex or Telegram or email or in open condition shall not be considered.
- v) Corrigendum, Addendum (if any) will be published in e-tendering portal (http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app) only.
- 3. **EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:** Not applicable.
- 4. Bidders who are on holiday list by NRL or any other Oil sector PSU will not be considered. Accordingly, the bidder shall submit a self-declaration as per format enclosed with Tender Document. It may be noted that if this declaration is found to be false, NRL shall have the right to reject bidder's offer, and if the bid has resulted in a contract, the contract is liable to be terminated.
- 5. **EVALUATION OF THE TENDER:** The evaluation shall be carried out on 'Overall L1 Basis' considering total no of chemicals & respective quantities for 03 years and unit rates for 03 years with loading of taxes, duties and other charges as applicable.

6. **PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (PQC):**

- i) The technical knowhow of the specialist supplier and guidance to be rendered for monitoring and troubleshooting though out the consumption of the chemicals shall be considered as important factor which has to be mentioned by the bidder at the time of tender.
- ii) Vendor should give list of present users with details of ongoing treatment of similar boiler with job completion certificate with boiler details & it should be from Indian PSU only.
- iii) Vendor has to give manufacturing certificate or dealership certificate from reputed manufacturer in case of dealer. Without these certificates no offer will be evaluated.
- iv) Each batch of material must contain test certificate, MSDS, Material data sheet, shelf life.
- v) The vendor is to mention the parameter and test method of offered chemical for verification at our NRL QC Lab at the time of offer along with active content.
- 7. The requirement of Prior Turnover and Prior Experience (if any, indicated in the tender document) will be relaxed if the bidder is Micro and Small Enterprise (MSE) or Startup and meets the quality and technical specifications described in the tender, subject to submission of valid supporting documents by the bidder.

This relaxation of prior turnover and prior experience will not be applicable for items related to public safety, health, critical security operation and equipment etc.

Supporting documents for MSE bidders:

- (i) MSE bidder must submit a copy of EM (Part-II)/ Udyog Aadhar Memorandum (UAM)* wherein bidder is registered as 'Micro/ Small Enterprise'.
- (ii) The MSE registration shall be valid as on date of placement of order
- (iii) The registration must be for the items/category of items relevant to the tendered items/category of items.

Supporting documents for Startup:

Bidder who intends to participate as 'Start-up'' company should enclose the Certificate of Recognition issued by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Govt. of India.

Note: Above supporting documents are required to be uploaded by bidder along with un-priced techno-commercial bid only. It is the responsibility of the bidder to upload the above supporting documents along with their un-priced techno-commercial bid for availing relaxation on Prior Turnover and Prior Experience (if applicable in this tender). In case of non-receipt of above documents along with bidder's un-priced bid, no further communication in this regard will be carried out to ascertain bidder's qualification as 'MSE bidder/ Startup' and relaxation on Prior Turnover and Prior Experience (if applicable in this tender) will not be passed on to bidder.

- b) Technical Specification and Terms & conditions duly filled, signed & signed.
- c) Agreed Terms & Conditions (ATC) duly filled, signed & stamped. The commercial terms & conditions should not be repeated in the offer.
- d) Bidder's Self-Declaration of black listing/ holiday listing as per Performa enclosed duly signed & sealed
- e) In case of Micro & Small Enterprise (MSE), bidders need to upload a copy of Udyog Aadhar Memorandum (UAM) / EM (Part-II) certificate for availing MSE benefit against the tender.
- f) In case of availing benefits under Purchase Preference Policy (Linked with Local Content) (PP-LC Policy), bidder to submit duly signed & sealed copy of per PP-LC Policy and 'Table 1: Calculation of Local Content Supply Contracts (Goods)' (i.e. Page 5 of 7 of PP-LC Policy) to be stated as 'Quoted in Priced Bid'.
- g) Vendor Details as per Format enclosed.

9. **DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED AS A PART OF PART – II: PRICED E-BID:**

- BoQ "in "XLS" format as per instructions provided. In BOQ, Bidder must indicate the no of chemicals & respective quantities in KG for 1st year, 2nd year & 3rd year along with their Unit Price and applicable P&F Charge, Freight change, Transit insurance & rate of GST as per instructions provided in BOQ.
- In case availing benefits under Purchase Preference Policy (Linked with Local Content) (PP-LC Policy) (as explained per PP-LC Policy), bidder shall provide break up of "Local component" and "Imported Component" along with their price bid (in PDF) as per format in 'Table 1: Calculation Of Local Content Supply Contracts (Goods)'; refer page 5 of 7 of PP-LC Policy.

10. <u>TENDERS FROM MICRO AND SMALL ENTERPRISES (MSEs)</u>: Refer Annexure-X enclosed.

11. **GENERAL:**

- i) Consortium/Joint venture bids shall not be accepted.
- ii) In case any of the document/information(s) furnished by a bidder are found to be false/forged, such bidder shall be kept in holiday list/ black list apart from other penal actions as deemed fit by NRL.
- NRL adopts a practice to verify documents submitted by L1 (successful) bidder in support of bidder's credential against PQC. Authentication may be verified with the issuing authorities, by way of direct communication to NRL over official e-mail IDs / Original letter of authentication by post. Bidders may also follow up with the issuing authority for eliciting early response. If documents remain unauthenticated till given time line, NRL reserves the right to reject the bid. Proper address for communication, including e-mail ID of the issuing authority should be provided along the tender document.
- iv) NRL reserves the right to defer the date/time of opening of the offer; to make changes in the terms & conditions of tender document and to reject any or all bids without assigning any reason thereof.
