Bidders have submitted their offer after visiting CPP portal considering that all clarification to pre-bid query/ corrigendum/ addendum (if any) have been published/ uploaded only in CPP Portal.

Scope of work and Supply:

The scope of work & supply of this work will be in accordance with the Tender Document, Schedule of Rates, technical specification, special conditions of contract, etc. and as per the direction of Engineer-in-charge.

Rate:

- The estimated rates will be displayed in the tender.
- The job is proposed to be divided into 2 groups i.e., Group –A (amounting to Rs. 6.46 Crs.): Flare Area & Group –B (amounting to Rs. 4.56 Crs.): MS Block area. However, the Engineer-in-charge may engage Group-A & Group-B in either of the areas as per job requirement.

- A bidder can opt for any of the groups or all i.e. Group A & B.

Variation of rate shall NOT be allowed on any account after due date & time of submission of offer.

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Evaluation Criteria:

- The tender item is 'Non-Splittable'
- Evaluation will be done on 'OVERALL LOWEST OFFER BASIS (LOADED VALUE)'
- MSE price preference policy Not applicable
- In case more than one agency becomes L1, percentage discount shall be asked from all of those L1 bidders. If the discount offered resulted more than one L1 bidder, the successful agency shall be decided through lottery among them.

Measurement of work:

Payment will be made on the basis of joint measurements, taken by the contractor and certified by Engineer-in-charge.

Terms of payment:

Payment will be made on the basis of item wise actual executed quantity, considered on monthly basis for RA bill; duly certified by Engineer-In-Charge (E-I-C).

The above payments are subject to deductions towards security deposit, income tax and other recoveries as applicable as per terms of the contract.

Penalty Clause

All penalty clause shall be governed by the provision of GCC. Decisions made by Engineer-in-Charge shall be the final and binding.

Other terms and conditions:

- (a) Tender containing uncalled for remarks or any additional conditions are liable to be rejected.
 - (b) The management of NRL reserves the right to reject any or all the bids received or annul the bidding process at any time without assigning any reason thereof.
 - (c) Variation in the value of the work will not vitiate the contract.
 - (d) The contractor will have to abide by the existing laws applicable to contract works and co-operate with other contractors working at site and will not cause hindrance to other works.
 - (e) The contractor shall observe all labour and other statutory rules and regulation of State/Central Govt. in force including the Safety and Environmental rules & regulations. In case of any violations of such laws, rules & regulations, the cost involvement thereof shall exclusively be borne by the contractor and the company shall have no liability whatsoever on this account.
 - (f) The contractor should engage workers preferably from the families of displaced persons to the extent available.
 - (g) Contractor will have to abide by the instructions of Engineer-in-charge as given from time to time.
 - (h) The General Conditions of contract of NRL will be applicable for this contract also. Intending tenderer may see the General Conditions of Contract of NRL at the Commercial Department of NRL site office on any working day during office hours or may visit our website www.nrl.co.in.
 - (i) Tenderer will fill up the all annexure attached to this Detailed Tender Notice. Tender in which any of the required particulars and prescribed information are missing or are incomplete, are liable to be rejected.
 - (j) Interested agencies may refer to www.eprocure.gov.in for results of bid opening.
 - (k) For applicable labour wage at NRL site & other relevant information regarding labour wages, kindly refer 'Circular of Wages for Contract Workmen'. This circular is available at NRL Website www.nrl.co.in (Tenders > Tender Manual under heading "Circular of Wages for Contract Workmen").
 - (l) No escalation of contract value (except hike in manpower rates), in any form whatsoever will be entertained during the contract period.
 - (n) No mobilization advance will be paid to the contractor for execution of this work.
 - (o) The contractor has to comply with all the statutory laws governing the execution of such type of jobs for which compliance certificate will have to be produced to the EIC.
 - (p) Insurance shall be effected for all employees of the contractor, engaged in the performance of the subject job. (Refer clause 104.1 (ii) of GCC).

- (q) The contractor has to accept full & exclusive liability for compliance with all obligations imposed by Employee State Insurance Act, 1948.
 - (r) The contractor is required to obtain labour license under Contract Labour (R&A) Act, 1970 & PF registration number on awarding the contract. The present rate of PF is 12% (Refer Clause 107.2 of GCC).
 - (s) The contractor will not engage minor labour below 18 (eighteen) years of age under any circumstances. The contractor will further comply with the provisions of the following act and indemnify the company against all claims, which may arise out of the following Acts, & Rules framed there-under:
 - (i) The Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act,
 - (ii) The Minimum Wages Act.
 - (iii) The contractor has to accept full & exclusive liability for compliance with all obligations imposed by Employee State Insurance Act, 1948.
 - (iv) The Workman's Compensation Act.
 - (v) The Payment of Wages Act,
 - (vi) The Payment of Bonus Act,
 - (vii) The Employees Provident Fund & Misc. Provisions Act,
 - (viii) Family Pension Scheme,
 - (ix) Inter State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment & Condition of Service) Act, or any other acts or statute not hereinabove specifically mentioned having bearing over engagement of workers directly or indirectly for execution of work.
 - (t) In case any of the document/information(s) furnished by a bidder are found to be false/forged, such bidder will be kept in holiday list apart from other penal actions as deemed fit by NRL.
 - (u) Agencies who are already blacklisted or under holiday list with NRL, MOP&NG or any other OIL PSU, against whom there is adverse report on committing criminal offence, their offers will be rejected.
 - (v) Bids submitted on consortium or un-incorporated joint venture basis shall be rejected.**
 - (w) Owner reserves the right to allow public sector enterprises (State/ central), purchase preference as admissible/ applicable from time to time under existing govt policies.**
 - (x) Bidders in their own interest shall furnish complete documentary evidence in the first instance itself along with their bids in support of fulfilling the BQC by them.**
 - (y) In case any bidder is found to be involved in cartel formation, their bid will not be considered for evaluation/ placement of order & the bidder will be debarred from bidding in future.**
 - (z) Canvassing in any form by the bidder or any other agency on their behalf may lead to disqualification of their bid.**
