1.0 Introduction

Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL) operates a 3.0 MMTPA Refinery at Numaligarh in the District of Golaghat, Assam since the year 2000. NRL has embarked on an ambitious path to expand its refining capacity from current 3 MMTPA to 9 MMTPA at its existing location in Assam in next 4 years.

The subject tender is intended to engage a Third-Party agency to perform Construction Safety Audit for the ongoing construction activities of Numaligarh Refinery Expansion Project, and involves the following:

- a) Initial site visit for adequacy assessment of existing work practices & Hazard identification and submission of report.
- b) Periodic assessment on monthly basis and submission of report.



Name of Work: "Construction safety audit at NREP site."

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2.0 Brief Scope of Work:

The complete scope of work and the basic scheme has been defined in the Technical Bid (Part-III). The bidder who undertakes to take total responsibility for the complete scope of work as defined in the Bidding document shall only be considered.

3.0 Pre-Qualification Criteria (PQC):

Bidder(s) who meet all of the following criteria as specified in Clauses below shall be qualified for participating in this tender and shall submit supporting documents as detailed in the tender. Proposal submitted by bidders who qualify as per the following criteria shall be technically and commercially evaluated.

3.1 Technical/ Past Experience Criteria:

- **3.1.1** The bidder shall either be a Third party Safety Audit firm or an Academic Institution imparting education on industrial safety.
- 3.1.2 The agency, in case of Academic institution imparting education on industrial safety, must have following minimum criteria:
 - a. Must run Certified safety program like Fire Management/ Safety Management/ Industrial Safety/ Disaster Management/Occupational Safety, Health and Environment Management and the institute shall be affiliated to any Central or State University.
 - b. Resource persons must have competency and Construction safety exposures with more than 50 years of combined experience in Operating Hydrocarbon environment. The bidder shall submit all biodata of the resource's persons in their offer.
 - c. At least 2 resource persons deputed for the job shall have fluency in verbal and written communication in Assamese (local language) as they are required to interact with the lower most category of workmen (more than 50% local) at safety site during audit to understand the safety environment.
- 3.1.3 The agency, in case of Third Party Safety Audit firm, must have the following minimum criteria:
 - a. Must have completed at least 2 numbers of construction safety audit/ surveillance safety audit/HSE Audit/ Statutory Compliance Audit etc in any industry.
 - b. Resource persons must have competency and Construction safety exposures with more than 50 years of combined experience in Operating Hydrocarbon environment. The bidder shall submit all biodatas of the resource's persons in their offer.
 - c. At least 2 resource persons must have fluency in verbal and written communication in Assamese (local language) as they are expected to interact with the lower most category of workmen (more than 50% local) during fact finding exercise.

Note:

1. Bidders are requested to confirm their valid GSTIN/UIN, PF and PAN along with the Bid Document, with a copy of the relevant certificates. NRL at its discretion may not consider the bidder's offer for further evaluation if the GSTIN/UIN is not valid/active. Any misinterpretation or misinformation with respect to GSTIN/UIN may attract penal action including putting the bidder on holiday / blacklisting as per rules in vogue at NRL.



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- 2. Bids from Consortium and Joint Venture Company shall not be accepted.
- 3. Bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings. Bidder shall submit a self-certificate to this effect.

SPECIAL NOTE TO THE BIDDERS:

Please note that relaxation of Pre-Qualification Criteria is not applicable for MSE. However, EMD waiver & price benefit to MSE & Start-up agencies shall be applicable as per prevailing policy.

4.0 Documents to be submitted by bidder:

- **4.1** Bidder should submit documentary evidence to support the references provided and fulfilling the Bidder's Qualifying Criteria (BQC) as mentioned under Clause 3.0 herein above.
- **4.2** The following are the minimum documents required:
- 4.2.1 Relevant documents as a proof of experience (relevant work orders / contract agreement /extracts/ experience certificate from authorized officials of PSU or Government Agencies, reputed private sectors).
- 4.2.2 The Bidder shall ensure submission of complete authentic information / documentation along with the bid.
- 4.2.3 NRL reserves the right to directly interact with the Bidder's clients to verify the relevant documentation and the Bidder will render assistance in facilitating the same.
- 4.2.4 All documents furnished by the bidder in support of meeting the PQC (including MSE Certificate) shall be submitted/uploaded in a separate folder titled "Documents towards PQC", duly signed and stamped by the bidder (in case of proprietorship firm) or "Power of Attorney" holder in case of Partnership /firm/Company. Copy of such "Power of Attorney" shall also be furnished with the unpriced bid.
- 4.3 In absence of requisite documents, NRL reserves the right to reject the Bid without making any reference to the Bidder or assigning any reason what-so-ever.
- **4.4** Bidders on "Holiday List of/debarred from business dealings by NRL/Oil PSUs /MOP&NG shall not be considered for evaluation and ordering.
- **4.5** NRL decision on any matter regarding short listing of bidders shall be final.
- 4.6 Submission of authentic documents is the prime responsibility of the Bidder. However, NRL reserves the right of getting the document cross verified, at their discretion from the document issuing authority. Bidder shall also facilitate such verification/ authentication of BQC documents and in case the documents remain unauthenticated till the given timeline, NRL reserves the right to reject such bid.
- **4.7** NRL reserves the right to complete the evaluation based on the details furnished (without seeking any additional information) and / or in-house data, survey or otherwise.
- **4.8** NRL reserves the right to further verify the bidder's credentials considered for evaluation.

5.0 Earnest Money Deposit:

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- 5.4 In case non -submission of Bid Security / EMD as mentioned above shall be considered as non-responsive and such Bids shall be rejected.
- **5.5** EMD exemption will be applicable only for registered Micro or Small Enterprises (MSEs) as specified by Ministry of Micro Small and Medium Enterprises.
- 6.0 Security Deposit/ Contract Performance Bank Guarantee (CPBG):
- 6.1 In line with Department of Public Enterprises (DPE)'s letter no. DPE/7(4)/2017-Fin. (Part I) dated 19th Nov' 2020, the rate of contract performance bank guarantee/ security deposit is hereby reduced to 3% of the value of contract.

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Appendix-B

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MSE BIDDERS

- a) As per Public Procurement Policy for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 issued vide Gazette Notification dated 23.03.2012 by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises of Govt. of India and GazetteNotification no. 2119(E) dated 26.06.2020 in supersession of Gazette Notification no. 1702(E) dated 01.06.2020, Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE's) must have UDYAM Registration Certificate (https://udyamregistration.gov.in) permitted by GOI w.e.f., 01.04.2021, to avail the benefits / preference available vide Public Procurement Policy MSEs Order, 2012.
- b) MSEs participating in the tender must submit the UDYAM Registration Certificate. Policy is meant for procurements of only goods produced and services rendered by MSEs. Stockist/Traders are excluded from the purview of public procurement policy.
- c) The UDYAM Registration Certificate must be valid as on close date of the tender.
- d) The MSEs who do not have the Udyam Registration Certificate as on close date of the tender, are not eligible for exemption / preference.
- e) UDYAM Registration Certificate shall be the sole registration document for qualifying as MSE. UAM and EM PartII Certificates issued by various bodies specified like NSIC, DIC, COIR Board, KVIC, KVIB, DHH, MSME etc. shall not be considered for qualification.
- f) In order for MSE owned by SC/ ST Entrepreneurs to qualify for benefits available under Public Procurement Policy for MSEs order 2012 to SC/ST entrepreneurs, the "Social Category" in Udyam Registration Certificate should state "SC" or "ST".
- g) If the Gender is clearly stated in UDYAM Registration, the same will be considered for evaluation and no other additional document will be required to qualify as Women owned MSE.
- h) The MSEs registered with UDYAM are exempted from payment of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).
- i) Following vendors shall not get MSE related benefits:
- i. MSEs registered as a Service Enterprise participating in a tender for supply of goods for which they arenot registered.
- **ii.** MSEs registered as Manufacturing Enterprise but participating in a tender for rendering services forwhich they are not registered
- **iii.** The preference to MSEs is not applicable for works contracts where supply of goods not producedby the MSEs is also involved
 - j) The value of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) shall be relaxed by 50% of the requirement as per tender terms in case of MSEs owned by SC/ST & Women entrepreneurs.

NOTE: -

- 1. In case where tender quantity can be split and MSE vendor is already getting order for more than 25% of the tender value, no additional purchase preference will be given in that tender.
- 2. In case MSE vendor is already getting order for less than 25% of the tender quantity, purchase preference to this and other MSE vendors (together) shall be given only up to the differential quantity to make total as 25% to MSE vendor.
