INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE EXTERNAL ON-STREAM INSPECTION OF PROCESS UNITS PIPING SYSTEM USING ADVANCE NDT METHODS AT NUMALIGARH REFINERY

- 1.0 Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL), India is a Public Sector Undertaking having 03 MMTPA Refinery Complex at Numaligarh, Assam.
- 2.0 Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL) invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from competent Indian/ Foreign vendors with sound technical expertise and capabilities for online inspection of refinery piping using advance NDTs to ascertain the mechanical integrity.
- 3.0 The work is planned to be awarded in one single Lump Sum Turn Key (LSTK) contracts on LSTK basis.
- 4.0 NDT methods to be proposed by the Agency and shall be capable to Inspect all types of plant piping with different thickness and materials operating at different operating temperature (550 deg C max.).
- 5.0 The work is planned to be carried with no or minimal insulation removal (if applicable) using the most effective NDT methods.
- 6.0 Scope of support services arrangement and execution required to carry out the Inspection lies with the Agency.

7.0 EXTERNAL ON-STREAM INSPECTION job schedule :

The planned milestone dates for these jobs are as follows:

| 3. | Start of EXTERNAL ON-STREAM INSPECTION | : November, 2017 |

- 8.0 NRL invites “Expression of Interest” (EOI) from competent bidders with sound technical and financial capabilities. The interested bidders should support their EOI with documents and company profiles, in sufficient details, to allow for initial appraisal of capabilities to perform the work outlined.

These details shall include, but not be limited to the following:

- i) Each bidder (and / or its joint venture / consortium partner's wherever applicable) must forward following information as a prerequisite for assessment of the bidders capability to execute turnaround jobs and short listing for issue of Pre Qualification Bid (PQ Bid) and Invitation To Bid (ITB) :
 - Experience for execution of at least two (2) nos. turn around maintenance activities in process plants i.e. Refinery or Petrochemicals or Fertilizers on :
 - a) LSTK basis
 - OR
 - b) Conventional basis(Domestic / International experience shall be mentioned)
 - Minimum executed value of at least one contract (executed individually by principle bidder and / or its joint venture / consortium partner's wherever applicable) for above work shall be Rs. 1 (one) crores and above. Bidder shall submit purchase order copies with scope of work and order value in support of the executed jobs.
- ii) Interested bidders shall also provide following information :
 - Planned / actual completion schedule and awarded / executed contract value for above jobs.
 - Any early completion bonus received by the bidders for these jobs shall be highlighted.
 - Specify minimum & maximum value of contract executed.
 - Specify the list of contracts presently being under execution with relevant contract value and present state of completion with schedule thereof.
- iii) Each bidder must forward their (and / or its joint ventures / consortium partner's wherever applicable) published balance sheets in support of financial strength for last three (3) preceding financial years.
- iv) Bidder wishing to pre-qualify as a part of a joint venture / consortium with another company must declare this fact in their EOI, specifying name(s) of the joint ventures / consortium partners, structure of a joint venture / consortium and their willingness to participate.

9.0 Special Conditions :

- i) The contract packages will be on a fixed price Lumpsum and/or schedule of rates (SOR) basis. Number of contract package may be one or more for ease of execution.

- ii) Interested bidders shall note that submission of EOI response does not guarantee any bidder the right of inclusion to formally pre-qualify for the turnaround jobs.
NRL reserves the right to reject any or all bidders submitting EOI without assigning any reasons or explanations whatsoever.
- iii) NRL will not be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by interested bidders in connection with the preparation and delivery of their EOI. All costs and expenses will be the sole responsibility of the interested bidders.
- iv) Telex / telegraphic / tele-fax / E-mail responses are not acceptable.
- v) No correspondence or communication in this regard will be entertained after the due date. Determination of capability to execute the EXTERNAL ON-STREAM INSPECTION be assessed solely on the responses received from the interested bidders and subsequent clarifications, if any, sought by NRL.
- vi) Interested bidders should note that EOI process is intended to short listing of bidders for issue of PQ Bid and ITB for the above mentioned LSTK contract on EXTERNAL ON-STREAM INSPECTION.

10. MODE OF SELECTION OF ACTUAL CONSULTANT

1. Obtain Expression of Interest (EOI) from interested agencies. Offers from interested agencies shall be scrutinized and shortlisted based on qualifying criteria specified in EOI.

11. SUBMISSION OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

The applicants should submit EOI applications along-with prescribed Forms A filled with supporting documents required for compliance of PQC (Pre-Qualifying Criteria) for the job.

Expression of Interest by interested parties can be submitted upto **11:00 AM on 08.08.2017**. EOI submitted afterwards will be summarily rejected. The interested parties may submit the EOI into electronic tender on the website <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>. Tenders and supporting documents should be uploaded through e-procurement portal only. Hard copy of the tender documents will not be accepted.
