

NUMALIGARH REFINERY LIMITED NOTICE INVITING TENDER

Two parts ONLINE bid (E-tender) offers are requested from competent and experienced domestic (Indian) bidders for following work:

Name of Work :	Design, Detail Engineering & Construction of 02 nos. of Pre-fabricated Warehouses for Storing Mandatory Spares at NRL, Numaligarh

PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

Subject job is a works contract and is not covered under the Public Procurement policy for MSEs. Hence, benefits to MSE and 'Start Up' bidders (except exemption from submission of EMD) are not applicable in this tender.

The intending bidders for above tender should meet all the qualification criteria given below:

- **A)** Past Experience of having successfully completed similar works* during last 10 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which the original bid due date falls, should be either of the following:
 - > One similar work costing not less than ₹ 571.51 Lakhs, or
 - ➤ Two similar works costing not less than ₹ 457.21 Lakhs each, or
 - **>** Three similar works costing not less than ₹ 342.91 Lakhs each.
- *Similar Works: The Bidder must have prior experience in the design and construction of prefabricated steel structures (excluding modular porta cabins, sheds, etc.) with a minimum built-up area of 1000 sqm for any government / private organization in India. The following types of structures will be considered:
- a. Construction of warehouse with structural steel roofing system in a single job
- b. Construction of Factory with structural steel roofing system in a single job
- c. Construction of Steel building/ stadium/ airport hanger with structural steel roofing system in a single job.

NOTE:

1) Relevant work order copies and corresponding completion certificate issued by Owner/Owner's Consultant are to be enclosed with offer. The completion certificate should consist of Name of Work, Work Order number & date, Actual executed value and Actual completion date. The date of completion of works as per the Completion Certificate will be considered for determining acceptability in respect of the qualifying past experience period as specified above.

In case of non-availability of completion certificate against each work order in the above format, the supplementary information may be submitted in the form of supporting document(s) issued by the same authority/office issuing the completion certificate.

- 2) Bidder shall also submit the Structural Design report approved by the client/owner/consultant.
- 3) The value of past experience shall be adjusted at a simple rate of 07% for every completed year and / or part thereof ending last day of the month proceeding the month in which the original bid due date falls. The values specified above are executed values, exclusive of GST / Service tax.

4) Unless otherwise specifically mentioned in the tender, Completion Certificate issued against incomplete / in-progress job will not be acceptable. However, successfully completed jobs of regular/repetitive nature, which are under extension for additional period, may also be accepted if Completion Certificate against the completed original contractual period (or completed extension extended) with corresponding executed value and date of completion is furnished. However, executed value pertaining to the ongoing extension period shall not be considered. [For example, if a contract is for 2+1 years, and the original 2 years or 2+1 years is completed but contract is still under extension for provisional (+1 year) / any further additional period, the certified value for only the completed 2 years or 2+1 years will be considered. However, in the same example, any Interim Work Completion Certificate for a part of the original contractual period of 2 years will not be considered]. Similarly, and unless otherwise specifically mentioned in the tender, for one-time projects where the project is successfully completed/commissioned but warranty/AMC etc. is ongoing may also be accepted if Completion Certificate against the project with corresponding executed value and date of completion is furnished.

B) AVERAGE ANNUAL TURNOVER, of the last 3 (three) financial years, shall be at least Rs. 342.91 Lakhs.

Bidders to submit copies of audited profit & loss account for the last three financial years in support of annual turnovers "or" certification of annual turnovers for the last three financial years from a registered chartered accountant firm. Last three financial years mentioned above refers to immediate three preceding financial years wherever the original last bid submission date is after 31st December. In case of tenders having original last bid submission date up to 31st December and audited / CA certified turnover documents of the preceding financial year is not available, the audited / CA certified turnover documents of the three years prior to preceding financial year will be considered. [May refer illustrative example given at Annexure-VII]

Note:- The average annual turnover is calculated by adding the turnovers of 03 the specified years, divided by 03. If a Bidder does not submit the aforementioned financial statements for three specified years, then Average Annual Turnover will be calculated based on financial figures of only those specified years for which requisite financial statements are submitted. Turnover will be considered '0' (Zero) for the year(s) for which requisite financial statements are not submitted.

Audited Annual Report / financial statements needs to be accompanied with UDIN number, which is mandatory from July 2019 onwards. Any Financial Report which is issued after July 2019 onwards without UDIN shall not be considered for evaluation.

IMPORTANT NOTE TO BIDDERS:

a) Notwithstanding any other condition / provision in the tender documents, bidders are required to submit complete documents pertaining to Pre-Qualification Criteria (PQC) along with their Bid. Evaluation may be completed based on the content of the Bid itself without seeking any subsequent additional information, which may result in rejection of Bid.

NRL at its discretion, may request bidder in writing, to submit the necessary information or documentation, within a reasonable period of time, to withdraw deviation, reservation, or rectify omission in the bid related to documentation requirements. If the tenderer does not comply or respond by the specified date, his tender will be liable to be rejected. No change in prices or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered or permitted. No post-bid clarification at the initiative of the bidder shall be entertained. If sought, the bidders can submit only the shortfall information/documents which pre-existed at the time of the tender opening and which have not undergone change since then.

So far as the submission of documents w.r.t. Pre-Qualification Criteria (PQC), after opening of the tenders is concerned, only related shortfall documents may be asked for and considered by NRL [For example, if the bidder has submitted a contract without its completion certificate, the certificate can be asked for and considered. However, no other contract (which was not enclosed or referred in their original Bid), shall be asked for so as to qualify the bidder]. That is, the bidder shall not be allowed to submit new references or documents w.r.t. PQC, which were neither enclosed nor referred to in their original Bid.

If the bidder cites any reference of a job executed for NRL in their original Bid and the bidder is not able to furnish documentary evidence, the internal records of NRL shall be considered.

b) It is to be noted that experience as the main contractor will only be taken in cognizance for the purpose of assessing qualifying criteria. However, a job completed by a Bidder as a sub-contractor shall also be considered for the purpose of meeting the technical and commercial experience criteria of BQC subject to submission of following documents in support of meeting the "Bidder Qualification Criteria":

- i) Copy of work order along with SOR issued by Main Contractor.
- ii) Copies of Completion/Mechanical completion/Commissioning Certificates (as the case may be) issued by the Owner/Owner's Consultant/**Main Contractor (countersigned by Owner/Owner's Consultant). The said Certificates shall have details like work order no. /date, brief scope of work, ordered & executed value of the job, completion date etc.
 - ** In case bidder is not able to furnish the Completion/Mechanical completion/Commissioning Certificates (as the case may be) from the Owner/Owner's Consultant in his name then the Certificate issued by Main Contractor shall also be considered as proof of completion of the relevant job, subject to countersigning of the aforesaid Certificate by the Owner/Owner's Consultant.
- iv) The subcontractor shall furnish either (a) TDS Certificate in Form 26AS (Annual Tax Statement under Section 203AA of the Income Tax Act, 1961) or (b) Bank Certificate indicating receipt of payment from the Main Contractor in case of overseas executions / executions under overseas organizations.
- c) In support of the experience and value of work executed, the sub-contractor or contractors under Private Organizations, shall furnish either (a) TDS Certificate in Form 26AS (Annual Tax Statement under Section 203AA of the Income Tax Act, 1961) or (b) Bank Certificate indicating receipt of payment from the Main Contractor or Private Organization(s) in case of overseas executions / executions under overseas organizations. This will be in addition to the copies of the relevant work order / letter of award and corresponding completion certificate(s).
- d) Consortium/Joint venture bids are not acceptable.
- e) NRL adopts a practice to verify documents submitted by L1 (successful) bidder in support of bidders credential against PQC. Authentication may be verified with the issuing authorities, by way of direct communication to NRL over official email IDs / original letter of authentication by post. Bidders may also follow up with the issuing authority for eliciting early response. If documents remain unauthenticated till given time line, NRL reserves the right to reject the bid. Proper address for communication, including e-mail ID of the issuing authority should be provided along the tender document.
- f) **Disqualification**: Even if an applicant meets the eligibility criteria and PQC, he shall be subject to disqualification if he (or any of the constituent partners in case of JV / Consortium / LLP) is found to have:
 - 1. Made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements, affidavits and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements; and/or;
 - 2. On account of currency of debarment by NRL / MoPNG.
- g) Contentions and Disputes: The PQC shall be interpreted on common usage of terminologies and phrases in this tender instead of legalistic and hair-splitting judgements and NRL's decision in this regard would be final. Hair-splitting, contentious or viciously legalistic interpretations of PQC criteria, disregarding the very rationale of the PQC shall not be entertained.
- h) Possession of Valid GST registration certificate: Unless exempted from GST registration, bidders are requested to upload their VALID GSTIN / UIN Certificate / GSTIN Number along with the Bid Document. NRL at its discretion may not consider the bidder's bid for further evaluation if the same is not found uploaded with the bid or not found to be valid in GST portal which may lead to rejection of the bid. Any misinterpretation or misinformation may attract penal action including putting the bidder on holiday / blacklisting as per rules in vogue at NRL.
- i) A job executed by a bidder for its own plant/projects shall not be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting requirement of BQC of the Tender. However, jobs executed for Subsidiary/Fellow subsidiary/Holding company, where the end client/user is a third party, will be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting BQC subject to submission of tax paid invoice(s) duly certified by Statutory Auditor of the bidder towards payments of statutory tax in support of the job executed for Subsidiary/ Fellow subsidiary / Holding company. Such bidders to submit these documents in addition to the documents specified above to meet BQC.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) Detailed Tender document should be downloaded from Central Public Procurement Portal http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app. Aspiring Bidders/ Suppliers who have not enrolled/registered in e-procurement should enroll/register before participating, through the website http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app.
- 2) Bidders can access tender documents from the website, fill them with all relevant information and submit the completed tender document into electronic tender on the website http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app.
- 3) Tenders and supporting documents should be uploaded through e-procurement portal only. Hard copy of the tender documents will not be accepted.

Both Technical bid and Financial bid are to be submitted concurrently, duly digitally signed in the web site http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app.
