1.0 INTRODUCTION

Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL), a Central Government Public Sector Undertaking and a subsidiary of Oil India Limited. NRL operates a 3.0 MMTPA Refinery at Numaligarh in the District of Golaghat, Assam since the year 2000. NRL is now executing a major expansion project of capacity augmentation from present 3.0 MMTPA to 9.0MMTPA. For decongestion of LPG, propylene and POL products in the existing set up in the refinery site in the event of the refinery expansion, NRL proposes to construct a new LPG and propylene facility at Dabidubi, Tehsil- Khumtai Revenue Circle, District-Golaghat, by transporting product from NRL refinery by pipeline. Transportation of the above products from the refinery shall be through underground pipelines. Under this project, NRL proposes to laying and installation of 8" dia LPG pipeline (300#) X 13.194KM approximately in common trench, from Numaligarh refinery to Dabidubi Plant.

VCS Quality Services Pvt. Ltd. (VCS) has been appointed as an Engineering Consultant by Client for the project "Numaligarh Refinery to Dabidubi Village Cross Country Pipeline Project." Accordingly, VCS on behalf of NRL invites bids executing the subject tender.

2.0 BRIEF SCOPE WORKS

The Contractor's Scope of Work for the work tendered shall consist of, but not be limited to, supply (as indicated in Scope of Supply), installation, testing, pre-commissioning checks and commissioning assistance for terminal/station works complete with all associated mechanical, civil, structural, electrical, instrumentation works as applicable including all such works which though specifically not indicated here but will otherwise be required to complete the WORK in all respects.

For detailed scope, refer Technical Volumes of tender document.

This document shall be read in conjunction with list of attachments, schedule of Rates (SOR), specifications, standards, drawings and other documents forming a part of the Tender document.

3.0 COMPLETION PERIOD:

Mechanical Completion and making the system ready for Pre-commissioning within **10 Months** from the date of issue of Letter of Acceptance plus **02 Months** for assistance for Pre-Commissioning and Commissioning.

5.0 PRE- QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (PQC):

The Bidder shall meet the following criteria-

5.1 PAST EXPERIENCE CRITERIA:

The bidder should have completed in last 10 (Ten) years ending last date of month previous to one in which bids are invited, at least one or two or three contracts of works for the value not less than as mentioned below:

(A) MECHANICAL WORKS

The Bidder should have completed Mechanical work in Hydrocarbon sector (Refineries, Petrochemical complex, Receiving Terminal / Dispatch Terminal / Marketing Terminal / Intermediate Pumping Stations/Gas Processing-On shore) / Fertilizer Sector of value not less than —

Mechanical Works means Mechanical works involving piping, equipment erection in Hydrocarbon Sector (Refineries, Petrochemical complex, Receiving Terminal / Dispatch Terminal / Marketing Terminal / Intermediate Pumping station / Gas Processing – On shore) / Fertilizer Sector.

Note:

- I) If the Past Reference submitted by Bidder includes equipment Supply component more than 30% of Total Completed value, then the value of the supply component exceeding 30% of the total Completed value of respective Past Experience shall not be considered for Bid Qualification purpose.
- II) If the Past Reference submitted by Bidder includes equipment Supply component less than or equal to 30% of Completed value, the Completed value of Past Experience shall be considered for Bid Qualification purpose.
- III) In case the bidder has executed a composite works. Which included the qualifying works as per the above Mechanical works, the value of such qualifying work out of the total value of composite work shall be considered for the purpose of qualification.

AND

(B) CIVIL & STRUCTURAL WORKS

In addition to bidder meeting experience criteria mentioned against (A) above, they should also have completed Civil & Structural Works of value not less than as mentioned below:

Civil & Structural works means Civil & Structural including RCC (in framing / Roof structures) and Structural Steel works in an Industrial Plant or in Hydrocarbon Sector (Refineries, Petrochemical complex, Receiving Terminal / Dispatch Terminal / Marketing Terminal / Intermediate Pumping stations / Gas Processing – On shore) / Fertilizer Sector.

AND

(C) ELECTRICAL WORKS:

In addition to bidder meeting experience criteria mentioned against (A) & (B) above, they should also have completed Electrical Works of value not less than as mentioned below:

(D) INSTRUMENTATION WORKS:

In addition to bidder meeting experience criteria mentioned against (A), (B) & (C) above, they should also have completed instrumentation Works of value not less than as mentioned below:

Instrumentation Works means Instrumentation works in an Industrial Plant or in Hydrocarbon Sector (Refineries, Petrochemical complex, Receiving Terminal / Dispatch Terminal / Marketing Terminal / Intermediate Pumping stations / Gas Processing — On shore) / Fertilizer Sector.

NOTE FOR CLAUSE NO 5.1:

- (i) In case Bidder does not meet the requirement indicated at clause no. (B), (C) and (D) above by their own but meet the requirements of clause no. (A) indicated above, they can engage one or more suitable subcontractor(s) [i.e. sub-contractor shall meet the Criteria mentioned at clause (B), (C) and (D) above by their own for Civil & Structural, Electrical Works and / or Instrumentation Works respectively] so that total requirement stated at clause (A), (B), (C) and (D) is met by the bidder along with their subcontractor(s).
- (ii) In case the bidder is getting qualified based on the experience of subcontractor, bidder shall not be permitted to change the subcontractor in the event contract is awarded to them without approval from EIC. The bidder shall submit the MOU with subcontractor and requisite documentary evidence as given in clause 5.3.1. There shall be no change in MOU with subcontractor after award of the job. This MOU must remain in force at least till the pendency of contract.
- (iii) The above sub-contractor shall not be permitted to participate in the bidding process in an individual capacity as 'a bidder'.
- (iv) A subcontractor to one bidder can be sub-contractor to other bidder (s) also.
- (v) The value of "similar work" shall be escalated at a simple rate of 7% for every completed year and thereafter at @ 0.58% for every completed month ending last day of the month preceding the month in which bids are invited.
- (vi) In case bidder [and/or their subcontractor] has executed a Composite Work which included the qualifying works (s) as per the above definition of similar work, the value of such qualifying work (s) out of the total value of Composite work shall be considered for the purpose of qualification.
- (vii) The value of experience in multidisciplinary work as stated above can either in a single contract or in multiple contracts.
- (viii)Industrial Plant means any premises, in any part of which, a manufacturing or production process is being carried out or ordinarily so carried on.
- (ix) In case, two separate Bidders submit reference of same work (wherein one was Main Contractor and the other was Sub-Contractor), both Bidders' experience shall be considered for qualification subject to Bidder's meeting other qualification requirements.
- (x) In case a Bidder submits PTR having job awarded for multiple Parts in single Work Order having separate completion schedule for each Part, and the Bidder wants to get qualified based on the completion of One or more Parts (irrespective of whether all Parts under the same work order are completed or not), which meets the subject PQC value-wise and with respect to Similar Work, the same may be considered subject to the completion certificate with executed value of that/those Part(s) from the Owner/End User/PMC for that/those Part(s).
 - However, where multiple-Parts work is awarded under different Work Order(s) having different Work Order reference number(s) with the same Enquiry Document No., cumulative value of such completed Work Orders meeting definition of Similar Work, as submitted, shall be considered for the purpose of PQC Evaluation.
- (xi) The above qualification Criteria is exclusive of GST/ Service taxes as applicable.
- (xii) It is to be noted that experience as main contractor will only be taken cognizance of for the purpose of assessing qualifying criteria. However, authorized sub-contractors under principal contractors

can also be considered provided their works completion certificate is issued by the client organization in case of job executed elsewhere under PSUs, limited companies, Government Departments, Quasi government and autonomous bodies. However, in case of sub-contractors under contractors engaged by NRL, the works completion certificate issued by the main contractor will also be acceptable provided the same is endorsed by Engineer-in-charge of NRL.

In support of the experience and value of work executed, the sub-contractor or contractors under Private Organizations, along with other document required in PQC, shall furnish either (a) TDS Certificate in Form 26AS (Annual Tax Statement under Section 203AA of the Income Tax Act, 1961) or (b) Bank Certificate indicating receipt of payment from the Main Contractor or Private Organization(s) in case of overseas executions / executions under overseas organizations.

5.2 FINANCIAL CRITERIA:

Bidder shall meet the following criteria as per the Financial Statements audited and issued on or before Bid Due Date (Final Bid Due Date after extension, if any) –

5.2.1 ANNUAL TURNOVER:

The minimum average annual turnover during three preceding financial years of the bidder as per the audited annual financial results shall be **INR 3.74 Crore.**

5.2.2 NET WORTH

The financial net-worth of the Bidder as per the immediate proceeding years audited annual financial results shall be positive.

Further, negative Net worth shall not be rejection criteria for CPSEs. Contract award shall be purely on competitive basis and CPSEs having negative Net worth shall furnish an undertaking in their Bid that performance shall not be compromised.

5.2.3 CALCULATION OF TURNOVER AND NET WORTH

a) Annual Turnover (for the Financial Statement pertaining to post GST regime):

Turnover shall be calculated excluding GST and other Incomes.

[Note: If the financial Statements is prior to implementation of GST, and the Excise Duty is shown extra in the Financial Statement, the Turnover shall be inclusive of Excise Duty but excluding other income]

b) Net worth calculation:

Net worth means paid up share capital, Share Application Money pending allotment* and reserves# less accumulated losses and deferred expenditure to the extent not written off. Net worth shall be calculated using the following formula:

Reserves to be considered for the purpose of net worth shall be all **reserves created out of the** profits **and securities premium account** but shall not include reserves created out of revaluation of assets, write back of depreciation and amalgamation.

*Share Application Money pending allotment will be considered only in respect of share to be allotted.

5.2.4 Financial years/ previous period as above shall be reckoned from the due date ending on the last day of the month immediately preceding the month in which the last date of bid submission falls.

5.3 DOCUMENTS AND DATA REQUIRED WITH BID

Bidders are required to submit all such past experience (s) (PTR) meeting the PQC along with relevant supporting documents in the first instance itself, along with the bid to justify that the bidder meets the Qualification criteria as given above. Accordingly, only such past experience (s) shall be considered for qualification, details of which are provided in the bid by the bidder and subsequently no additional past experience (PTR) shall be sought from the Bidder.

5.3.1. **Documents towards Past Experience Criteria**:

- 5.3.1.1 The bidder shall, in his own interest, furnish complete documentary evidence to justify that the bidder [and/or his proposed sub-contractor] meets the Commercial Experience Qualification Criteria as given above.
- 5.3.1.2 Copies of Work order, Completion certificate from Owner/ End User / PMC etc. in the name of the Bidder [and/or his proposed sub-contractor] meeting requirements as laid in clause no. 5.1.
- 5.3.1.3 Bidder [and/or his proposed sub-contractor] shall submit documentary proof such as Scope of works/specification/survey reports/drawings (for civil works / roofing structure, Structural Works)/Invoices/Final Bill or any other documentary evidence to substantiate the completed value of similar work and to establish the Similar Work as defined in clause no 5.1(A), 5.1(B), 5.1(C) & 5.1(D) correlating the work order and completion certificate.
- 5.3.1.4 In case Bidder [and/or his proposed sub-contractor] has executed Composite Works which includes the qualifying work(s) as per the definition of similar works mentioned in clause no 5.1, then the value of such qualifying work(s) out of the total value of Composite Works shall be considered for the purpose of qualification.
- 5.3.1.5 Bidder shall submit documentary evidence along with declaration regarding value of supply portion in submitted PTR.

5.3.2. Documents towards Financial Criteria:

Bidder shall submit the following documents to substantiate the Financial PQC:

Complete **Audited Financial Statement** (which includes 'Balance Sheet' and 'Profit & Loss Account' along-with the all schedules, Notes referred to therein and the Auditor's report) audited and issued on or before bid due date for preceding **Three (3) Financial Years**.

Notes towards Financial Documentation:

- a) Financial Statements of Latest Years: Bidders to submit copies of audited profit & loss account for the last Three financial years in support of annual turnovers "or" certification of annualturnovers for the last three financial years from a registered chartered accountant firm. Last Threefinancial years mentioned above refers to immediate 3 preceding financial years wherever the last bid submission date is after 30th Sept. In case of tenders having last bid submission date upto 30th September, and audited / CA certified turnover documents of the preceding financial years not available, the audited / CA certified turnover documents of the 3 years prior to preceding financial year will be considered.
- b) Bidder shall submit Standalone Financial Statements. However, Consolidated Audited Financial Statements are acceptable in following situations:

- (i) **Bidder is a Parent/Holding Company:** Where only consolidated Audited Financial Statements are prepared and audited, which includes the financial details of their wholly owned subsidiaries etc., consolidated audited financial statement shall be considered for establishing the financial criteria subject to Statutory Auditor, certifying that standalone Financial Statements of Bidder (without the financial data of subsidiaries, etc.) is not separately prepared and audited.
- (ii) Bidder is a Subsidiary Company: In case a Bidder is a Subsidiary Company and separate Financial Statements of the Bidder is not prepared & audited, but only a consolidated audited Financial Statements of their Parent Company/Holding Company are available, consolidated audited Financial Statement shall be considered for establishing the financial criteria subject to Statutory Auditor of the Parent/Holding company (whose Audited Financial Statements are submitted for qualification) certifying in their letterhead that Financial Statements of Bidder are not separately prepared and audited.
- c) Annual Financial details shall have to be submitted along with the original offer within the bid due date. The Financial details submitted after bid due date will not be considered for evaluation, however, any missing document (issued prior to the bid due date) pertaining to the details furnished in the offer shall be allowed for submission.
- 5.4 Bidder should have minimum prescribed domestic value addition requirement in linewith the Domestically Manufactured Iron & Steel Policy (DMI&SP) for the Iron & Steelproducts involved in execution of the contract. Bidder shall submit affidavit from the domestic manufacturers of such Iron & Steel products as per the Format enclosed in ANNEXURE 4 to ITB with the policy document.

A bidder who is not manufacturer of Iron & Steel products and is unable to submit the affidavit from domestic manufacturers at bidding stage, such bidder can submit the affidavit issued by domestic manufacturers after placement of order. In this case bidder along with his bid shall submit an undertaking as per attached as **Appendix-C** to this IFB.

If a bidder does not submit above affidavit or undertaking as per format, the offer of bidder shallbe rejected.

5.5 If a Bidder quotes for more than one part, then its evaluation for each part shall be done individually on standalone basis and wherever, in such evaluation, the bidder meets the qualifyingcriteria for a particular part/ parts, the bidder's price bids will be opened for that part/parts. Accordingly, in case bidder becomes L1 for multiple parts but does not meet the consolidated PQC (Commercial as well as Financial) of those parts as specified above, the selection of part foraward will be decided based on the evaluation of least to NRL, with permutation / combination of different possible options.

5.6 Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN):

Bidder shall ensure that the certificate/reports issued/attested by practicing Chartered Accountant (CA)/Statutory Auditor in India shall contain Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) of the CA, without which these Certificates/ reports shall not be considered for evaluation.

However, this requirement of including UDIN shall not be applicable for certificate/reports issued/attested by a CA practicing in foreign country.

5.7 Authentication of PQC documents:

- 5.7.1 It is Bidder's prime responsibility to submit genuine and authentic documents. No amount of checking or verification by VCS/NRL shall absolve Bidder from his responsibility.
- 5.7.2 All documents furnished by the bidder in support of meeting the Pre-Qualification Criteria (PQC) shall be:

Submitted duly certified by Statutory Auditor of the bidder or a practicing Chartered Accountant (not being an employee or a Director and not having any interest in the bidder's company) where audited accounts are not mandatory as per law.

OR

Submit documents duly notarized by any notary public in the bidder's country or certified true copies duly signed, dated and stamped by an official authorized for this purpose in Indian Embassy/ High Commission in Bidder's country."

OR

Bidder shall submit self-certified documents from any one out of CEO or CFO or Company Secretary of the bidder (Limited company only) along with Self- Certification as per Appendix-A to IFB [Format-A]. In addition to above, Bidder shall furnish an undertaking in the format enclosed herewith as per Annexure-B to IFB [Format-B], from the same authority (authorities) who had signed and authenticated the documents.

OR

In case of PSU, the Power of Attorney holder duly authorized by the Board shall self-certify the PQC documents.

- 5.7.3 Bidder shall upload the authenticated copies of documents duly digitally signed, onthe e-procurement website. Hence submission of physical PQC document is not required.
- 5.7.4 Submission of authentic documents shall be the prime responsibility of the bidder. Wherever VCS/NRL has concern or apprehension regarding the authenticity/ correctness of any document, VCS/NRL reserves the right to get the documents verified from issuing authority/any relevant source. If documents (part or full) are found forged, such offers will be summarily rejected, EMD will be forfeited, orders if any placed against subject tender will be terminated and may be debarred from future tenders. For the purpose of verification bidders shall submit complete client details with names, address, phone number, e-mail ID etc.

It shall, therefore, be responsibility of the bidder/ contractor to get their PQC documents considered for qualification successfully verified as above. Bidders may also follow up with the issuing authority for eliciting early response. If documents remain unauthenticated till given time line, NRL reserves the right to reject the bid.

Accordingly, bidder shall ensure that they submit those executed works meeting the qualification criteria for which they can arrange such verification.

The documents submitted by L1 bidder in support of their credentials against PQC shall be mandatorily verified with the issuing authorities.

5.8 OTHER POINTS:

5.8.1 Bidder's past experience as Consortium/Unincorporated Joint Venture (JV):

While evaluating the Bids, Bidder's past experience as a leader or member of a Consortium/Unincorporated Joint Venture (JV) shall be considered acceptable, providedhis scope in that Consortium/JV meets the requirement stipulated in the subject PQC under evaluation.

In case, the PTR of Consortium/ Unincorporated Joint Venture (JV) experience submitted by the Bidder meets the similar work without indicating the division of scope of work in terms of specific activities and associated value of work between the Consortium/ Unincorporated Joint Venture (JV) members, but only the division of scope in terms of percentage share is indicated, in such case the completed value shall be arrived at after considering percentage share of each member, for the purpose of PQC evaluation.

5.8.2 Experience of Bidder [and/or their proposed Sub-Contractor] as a Sub-Contractor:

A job completed by a Bidder as a Sub-Contractor shall be considered for the purpose of meeting the experience criteria of PQC, provided the appointment of Sub-Contractor was authorized and subject to submission of following documents in support of meeting the "Pre-Qualification Criteria":

- a) **Documentary evidence/Certificate by the end-User/Owner/PMC**, with regards to approval of Bidder/ engaging Bidder/ execution by the Bidder as a Sub-Contractor to the Main Contractor
- b) Work order and Completion Certificates indicating the value of works and date of completion issued by Main Contractor (including SOR, wherever required for establishing scope of work).
- c) Income Tax Return 23AS evidencing receipt of payment from the principal contractor.

5.8.3 Experience of Own Projects:

Experience of only the Bidding entity shall be considered. A job executed by a Bidder for its own plant/projects shall not be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting the Qualification Criteria of the Enquiry document.

However, Jobs executed for Subsidiary/ Fellow Subsidiary / Holding company shall be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting PQC, subject to submission of additional document towards "tax paid invoice(s) duly certified by Statutory Auditor of the Bidder or consolidated statement issued by Statutory Auditor of the Bidder towards payments of statutory tax" in support of the job executed for Subsidiary/ Fellow subsidiary / Holding company.

In case referred Project falls under "No Tax Area" (like SEZ), Bidder can submit certificate from their Statutory Auditor to this effect in place of Tax paid invoice.

Chartered Accountant (CA) (in place of Statutory Auditor) is acceptable where audited accounts are not mandatory as per law for latest financial year. Also CA shall not be an employee/ Director and not having any interest in the Bidder's company/Firm.

6.0 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD) / BID SECURITY;

- **6.1** Bids must be accompanied with Earnest Money Deposit / Bid Security as per proforma enclosed in ITB of value as specified in Proposal Form-D.
- **6.2** Bids not accompanied with requisite Earnest Money deposit / Bid Security shall be considered as non-responsive and such Bids shall be summarily rejected.
- **6.3** Bidder must submit original EMD in a sealed envelope to Tender issuing Authority (instructions and address mentioned in ITB) within bid due date time and upload a scan copy of EMD or proof of submission of online EMD on e-Tendering Website.
