ii) PART - II : Price Bid

- ii) This Tender is being conducted in e-tendering mode and the Bid documents can be downloaded for ONLINE bidding by the bidders, who has the Digital Signature Certificates.

- iv) Bids received by way of Post, Courier, Fax, Telex or Telegram or email or in open condition shall not be considered.
- v) Subsequent Corrigendum/Addendum (if any) shall be uploaded in CPP Portal only.

3. **BID-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (BQC):**

(i) Bidder shall be manufacturer of Steel Pipes as per ASTM A200 T5/T91/T11 & A 335 Gr P5/P11 standards as the case may be and shall have capability of manufacturing, testing and supplying the Steel Pipes as per NRL specification.

Vendor's action: Bidder is required to submit list of machineries, catalogue/brochures indicating their manufacturing and testing facilities.

Bidder should quote based on the range of their manufacturing sizes only.

Vendor's action: Bidder should confirm their manufacturing size range.

Vendor's action: Vendor shall confirm and substantiate all above conditions through proper documents.

(ii) The Bidder shall have successfully executed Purchase Orders for supply of Steel Pipes as per ASTM A200 T5/T91/T11 & A 335 Gr P5/P11 standards to any processing plant or any other industry directly or through project consultant(s), in any of the 12 consecutive months' period during preceding 5 years counting prior to tender due date and shall not be less than Rs. 30 lakhs.

The order value criteria mentioned above shall be basic cost without taxes and duties.

Vendor's action: Bidder is required to submit relevant Purchase order copies and invoices / Inspection Release Notes / completion certificates or any other such documents in proof of meeting this requirement.

**Vendor shall provide details of Work orders under which they are claiming qualification against individual items in Excel sheet form. In absence of this excel sheet offer/bid shall not be considered for evaluation.

(iii) Bidder should have relevant ISO Certification for their manufacturing processes and quality management.

Vendor' action: Vendor shall confirm and furnish relevant documents/copies of valid ISO certificate

(iv) Materials shall be delivered within 20 weeks from the placement of Order/LOI on FOR basis to NRL site.

4. <u>DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED AS A PART OF PART – I: TECHNO-COMMERCIAL / UNPRICED E-BID:</u>

- a) Documents in support of BQC of the Tender.
- b) Agreed Terms & Conditions (ATC) duly filled, signed & stamped. The commercial terms & conditions should not be repeated in the offer.
- c) Integrity Pact- duly signed & sealed.
- d) Bidder's Self-Declaration of black listing/ holiday listing as per Performa enclosed duly signed & sealed
- e) 'UNDERTAKING' on account of Anti-profiteering provision under the Goods & Services Tax ("GST") Law(s) as per Performa enclosed duly signed & sealed.
- f) Vendor Details as per Format enclosed.
- g) In case of MSE, Documents pertaining to MSE registration documents as per clause no. 6 of NIT below.
- h) All Technical documents duly signed& stamped.

- 6. TENDERS FROM MICRO AND SMALL ENTERPRISES (MSEs): This tender is guided by the Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) notified by the Government under the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise Development Act, 2006, which came into effect from 1st April, 2012. The Ministry of MSME published an order known as Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order 2012 under which Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) shall be entitled for benefits, subject to terms and conditions as per ANNEXURE "X" enclosed.
- 7. **EVALUATION OF THE TENDER:** Tender shall be evaluated on 'Item wise Lowest Offer Basis'.

8. **GENERAL:**

- i) Bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings. Bidder to submit the self certificate in this regard.
- ii) Agencies submitting their bids shall not be on Holiday list of NRL or any other Oil PSE. Accordingly, the bidder shall submit a self-declaration as per format enclosed with Tender Document. It may be noted that if this declaration is found to be false, NRL shall have the right to reject bidder's offer, and if the bid has resulted in a contract, the contract is liable to be terminated.
- iii) Consortium/Joint venture bids shall not be accepted.
- iv) Canvassing in any other form by the bidder or by any other agency on their behalf may lead to disqualification of their bid.
- v) In case any of the document/information(s) furnished by a bidder are found to be false/forged, such bidder shall be kept in holiday list/ black list apart from other penal actions as deemed fit by NRL.
- vi) NRL reserves the right to defer the date/time of opening of the offer; to make changes in the terms & conditions of tender document and to reject any or all bids without assigning any reason thereof.
