- 4.0 Agencies submitting their bids shall not be on Holiday list of NRL or any other Oil PSE. Accordingly, the bidder shall submit a self-declaration as per format enclosed with Tender Document. It may be noted that if this declaration is found to be false, NRL shall have the right to reject bidder's offer, and if the bid has resulted in a contract, the contract is liable to be terminated.

# 5.0 PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (PQC):

# 5.1. **TECHNICAL CRITERIA:**

- 5.1.1 Bidder shall be OEM of the offered crane or an Indian sales & service partner of the OEM. The Indian partner shall be in the business of crane manufacturing in India for last 05 years to be reckoned from final bid submission close date.
- 5.1.2 Bidder (OEM/ OEM''s Indian Partner) must have supplied minimum 03 (three) units of the offered crawler crane model in last 5(five) years in India and are in working condition.
- 5.1.3 Bidder must have existing after sales customer support network in India specifically for the offered crane model.

NRL reserves the right for independent verification of the references provided. Any negative feedback from any of the Clients on the performance and reliability shall lead to the rejection of the bid.

# 5.2 **FINANCIAL CRITERIA:**

5.2.1 Networth of the bidder should be positive as per the audited financial results for the immediate preceding financial year (i.e. FY 2016-17).

The offer of the bidder whose Networth is 'Negative' in the immediate preceding financial year shall not be considered for evaluation.

Networth means paid up share capital, Share Application Money pending allotment\* and reserves\*\* less accumulated losses and deferred revenue expenditure to the extent not written off.

- \*\* Reserves to be considered for the purpose of Networth shall be all reserves created out of the profits and securities premium account but shall not include reserves created out of the profits and securities premium account but shall not include reserves created out of revaluation of the assets, write back of depreciation and amalgamation.
- \* Share Application Money pending allotment will be considered only in respect of share to be allotted.

# 9.0 <u>TENDERS FROM MICRO AND SMALL ENTERPRISES (MSEs):</u>

This tender is guided by the Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) notified by the Government under the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise Development Act, 2006, which came into effect from 1st April, 2012. The Ministry of MSME published an order known as Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order 2012 under which Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) shall be entitled for benefits, subject to terms and conditions as per ANNEXURE "X" enclosed.

# 10. <u>ADDITIONAL CONDITION OF THE TENDER (applicable for Indian bidders):</u>

The requirement of Prior Turnover and Prior Experience (if any, indicated in the tender document) will be relaxed if the bidder is Micro and Small Enterprise (MSE) or Startup and meets the quality and technical specifications described in the tender, subject to submission of valid supporting documents by the bidder.

This relaxation of prior turnover and prior experience will not be applicable for items related to public safety, health, critical security operation and equipment etc.

# **Supporting documents for MSE bidders:**

- (i) EM-2 certificate or Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum wherein bidder is registered as 'Micro/ Small Enterprise'.
- (ii) The MSE registration must be for the items/category of items/services relevant to the tendered items/category of items /services.

# **Supporting documents for Startup:**

Bidder who intends to participate as 'Start-up' company should enclose the Certificate of Recognition issued by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Govt. of India.

Note: Above supporting documents are required to be uploaded by bidder along with unpriced bid only. It is the responsibility of the bidder to upload the above supporting documents along with their un-priced techno-commercial bid for availing relaxation on Prior Turnover and Prior Experience (if applicable in this tender). In case of non-receipt of above documents along with bidder's un-priced bid, no further communication in this regard will be carried out to ascertain bidder's qualification as 'MSE bidder/ Startup' and relaxation on Prior Turnover and Prior Experience (if applicable in this tender) under the above mentioned additional condition will not be passed on to bidder.

# 10.0 GENERAL:

- Bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings. Bidder to submit the self-certificate in this regard as per format enclosed.
- In case of Foreign Bidder, if any of the documents in support of meeting PQC are not in English language, then the English translation copy of the same duly certified, stamped and signed by Local Chamber of Commerce shall be furnished along with the document in the un-priced bid.
- 10.3 Consortium/Joint venture bids shall not be accepted.
- In this tender, either the Indian Agent/ Authorized representative in India on behalf of the foreign Principal (i.e. OEM) can bid but both cannot bid in the same tender. No Foreign Principal can engage/ authorize more than one Indian Agent/ Authorized representative in India.
- In order to consider offer submitted by Indian Agent/ Authorized representative in India on behalf of Foreign Principal (i.e. OEM), Foreign Principal (i.e. OEM) must meet the PQC requirement of the Tender. Single Point Responsibility for execution of the complete job (as per scope of tender) shall be with Foreign Principal (i.e. OEM) only.
- 10.6 Canvassing in any other form by the bidder or by any other agency on their behalf may lead to disqualification of their bid.
- In case any of the document/information(s) furnished by a bidder are found to be false/forged, such bidder shall be kept in holiday list/ black list apart from other penal actions as deemed fit by NRL.
- In case any bidder is found to be involved cartel formation, his bid will not be considered for evaluation/placement of order. Such bidder will also be debarred from bidding in future.
- 10.9 EMD is not applicable for this Tender.
