Q.N.1. How much money have been sanctioned by working corporation on the pipeline work to the given R.O.R. details i.e. khata no. 7 plot no. 173 and 174 of Odisha State, Balasore District, Sadar Balasore Tahasil, R. I. Odangi mouza, Talasingarapur.

Reply: An area of 1000 sqm and 200 sqm have been acquired for R.O.U. (Right of use) in respect of plot number 173 & 174 under khata no. 7 of village Talasingarapur respectively. The total amount for the above ROU area as sanctioned amounting to Rs. 1,32,600/-.

Q.N.2 They have done the pipeline work on my plot without any information to me or any notice. So I request you to work on this.

Reply: On verification of ROR khata no. 7 of village. Talasingarapur stands recurred in the name of Akhila Swain S/o Nila Swain of village Tala Amara. As per provision of P&MP act 1962 the mandatory notice u/s 3(1) and 6(1) of the Act were issued the R.T. named Akhila Swain which were received by Rabindra Swain (son) and Gajendra Swain (grand son) of the deceased R.T.

During preparation of ROR, it was noticed that R.T. Akhila Swain is dead leaving his 2 sons namely Rabindra Swain, Babu Swain and 3 daughters namely Muni, Tuni & Jhuni Swain and wife Saraswati Swain as successors in interest. At the spot, Rabindra Swain was present and prepare panchanama in his favour basing on exclusively field possession. Besides, he has submitted one affidavit regarding absence of the other co-shares. In this affidavit he has declared to refund of the compensation money, if any objection would received from any of his co-shares in future. Out of the co-shares, Babu Swain raised an objection regarding non receipt of his share of compensation for the above mentioned plots. Considering his application Rabindra Swain S/o Akhila Swain the recipient of the compensation money was noticed to refund the entire amount Rs. 1,32,600/- within 7 days vide this office notice no. 30 Dt. 16.02.23. But Rabindra Swain has not yet been refunded the amount for which further action is being taken to get the compensation money refunded.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL PROCEDURE (FOR MANAGEMENT STAFF)

It has always been the endeavour of the Company to resolve grievances of Officers as satisfactorily and speedily as possible.

01. Officers may take recourse to the following procedure for having their grievance attended to :

- i) An Officer of the Company having a grievance may report his grievance in writing to his immediate Controlling Officer giving the facts of the case in complete details.
- ii) Immediate Controlling Officer will acknowledge the receipt of the written advice of the grievance to the Officer concerned.
- iii) Facts as given in the grievance report will be examined by the immediate Controlling Officer and if necessary an interview may be given by him to the Officer concerned to clarify any point. Comments on the grievance report, along with a copy of it, will be sent by him (through the Officer he reports to) to HOD/GM/Director. The HOD/GM/Director will get the grievances examined in detail and grant an interview to the Officer concerned in order to explain to him the point of view of the administration and also mention to him the details of any remedial action taken to settle his grievance. If the aggrieved Officer is not satisfied with the explanation, it may be referred to MD whose decision shall be final. He shall have the option to interview the aggrieved Officer and consult his immediate Officer or HOD/GM/Director, if considered necessary.

Normally all grievances should be disposed of within a month, but if for any reason it takes a longer time, the Officer reporting a grievance may be kept advised by the Competent Authority with regard to the reasons for the delay in the disposal of his grievances.

- iv) Apart from following the formal grievance procedure, it is felt that since Officers of all grades have frequent opportunities available to them to contact their Senior Officers and even the HOD/GM/Director during the course of their official work, it should be possible for them to apprise their seniors about their grievances and in turn the Senior Officers should take note of such grievances and get them examined and settled. As far as possible, Officers may get their grievances settled by personal contact with their Senior Officers who should also give such matters their personal and immediate attention and get them settled by discussing the matter with the competent authority in each case.

02. For Officers in Grade 'E' and above, their grievances may receive attention at the level of MD and they can meet the MD through their HOD/GM/Director with prior appointment. It may also be advisable for them to discuss their grievances with GM(HR & CC) before meeting the MD.

03. **Overall Guidelines and Conditions**

- i) The Officer shall bring up his grievance immediately and in any case within a period of 3 months of its occurrence.
- ii) If the grievance arises out of an order given by the Management, the said order shall be complied with before the Officer concerned invokes the procedure laid down herein for redressal of his grievance.
- iii) Grievance pertaining to or arising out of the following shall not come under the purview of the grievance procedure :
 - a) Annual Performance Appraisals/Confidential Reports;
 - b) Promotions including OPPC's minutes and decisions;
 - c) Transfers & Placements;
 - d) Where the grievance does not relate to an individual Officer;
 - d) In the case of any grievance arising out of discharge or dismissal of Officer.
- iv) Grievance pertaining to or arising out of disciplinary action or appeal against such action shall be channelled to the competent authority as laid down under the Conduct, Discipline and Appeal Rules for Management Staff and in such cases the grievance redressal procedure will not apply.

GRIEVANCE HANDLING PROCEDURE FOR WORKMEN AT NRL

A Grievance Procedure is primarily a matter of internal administration and for this reason, the existing labour legislations have not made any elaborate provisions for redressal of day-to-day grievances in Industrial establishments. Individual complaints affecting one or more employees in respect of their wage payment, overtime, leave, transfer, promotion, work assignment, working conditions, amenities, implementation of service agreement and other matters incidental thereto can be settled as expeditiously as possible through the established machinery. Therefore, speedy disposal of workmen's grievance is the primary objective of having a Grievance Procedure. Disputes and differences, as far as practicable, should be settled as near as possible to the place of origin and reference to outside authorities should be kept to a minimum.

The procedure in regard to handling of workmen's grievances in the Company is detailed below :-

I

- (a) An employee who has a complaint may submit this verbally or in writing to his immediate senior officer .
- (b) The employee should get a reply within 3 days and if the employee is not satisfied with the reply given or action taken by his immediate superior Office he may submit his complaint in writing, through this Officer, to the Head of the Department for appropriate action.
- (c) If the employee is still not satisfied with the reply given or action taken by Head of his Department (the HOD should reply within 7 days), he may submit his complaint in writing through the Head of his Department to Chief Manager (P&A).
- (d) Departmental Officers are expected to handle employees' complaints or grievances as expeditiously as possible and reply to it or act upon it without delay. Departmental Officers are not permitted to hold up written complaints which are submitted to them.

II

A workman has the right of access to the Chief Manager (P&A) or his Deptl. Officers during working hours to obtain information /advice and, at any time during the procedure outlined in (a), (b) or (c) above.

Similarly, Deptl. Officers may make full use of the P&A Department to obtain information / guidance in order that grievances may as far as possible be eliminated.

- III. (a) if an employee is not satisfied with the reply given or action taken by CM (P&A), (CM(P&A) should reply/act within 3 days), then he may submit a

complaint in writing through the Head of his department to his Functional Head (Functional Head should resolve the issue within 3 days) If he is still not satisfied with the reply given or action taken by the functional head, he may submit his complaint to the Union of which he is a member. The Union Officials, if they consider the complaint justified, may take up the complaint on the employee's behalf and write to CM(P&A) or P&A Functional Head stating their views regarding the matter and requesting that the complaint should be carefully investigated.

- (b) if the Union is not satisfied with the reply given by CM(P&A) or Functional Head of P&A or feel that the complaint has not been thoroughly investigated, the Union may raise the issue with Advisor (HR) or may request that the complaint be added to the Agenda for discussion at Union-Mgt. Meeting. Union-Mgt. Meetings are held at regular intervals at which management and the members of the recognised Union discuss problems of industrial relations and matters arising out of employment, implementation of agreement, revision of terms and conditions etc. Employees personal grievances are also discussed and settled at such meetings.
- (c) Should the Union not be satisfied with the stand taken by the Company with regard to any issue which has been submitted by the Union for discussion at a Union Mgt. Meeting the Union may, if it so wishes, refer the complaint to the appropriate authority under the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.

(IV)

There is a tendency, however, for workmen to forward their individual complaints direct to the Head of Department/ Head of P&A / Functional head or even direct to the Union without first approaching their immediate superior Officer. The Company's Policy in such cases is to direct the employees to follow the established grievance procedure.

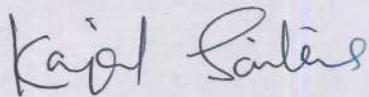

VIEWS OF THE PUBLIC :

Abhibartan Goswami, AASU, Golaghat Zila spoke that NRL is only one Accord Refinery as it is established in consequence of Assam Agitation from 1979 to 1985 and also on Assam Accord. The local people gave full support to NRL from time to time and AASU also gave full support to all their Project. NRL will move forward and hope that job will generate for the youths of not only Panka, Numoligarh, Golaghat but for all over Assam. The Pollution Control Board, Assam arrange this Public Hearing and in the hearing he came to know from Project Proponent that there will be less pollution in the expansion project and so he spoke in favour of the expansion project. He said NRL is the hope and desire of all people and so it remain at the heart of the people. He ~~is~~ spoke in favour of the expansion project.

Abdul Hasim, President, Assam Jatiyatabadi Yuva Chatra Parishad (AJYCP), Golaghat Zila Committee spoke that NRL is not a Refinery but it is a caste self respecting unit. It is Assam national resource. 855 martyrs sacrifice their life and in consequence of it and Assam Accord this industry was established. So with this unit their feeling, conscience and respect are linked. They wants that there should be development in the socio-economic line and they want to become relieve from unemployment problem and so they need industry and NRL expansion project brings hope to them and hence they fully support the NRL expansion project and request other to do the same.

Dhruvrajoti Bera spoke that inspite of unfavourable weather many people attended the hearing. He spoke that people has many hopes that job will be generate from this expansion project and they will get absorb in it and so they are in favour of the Project. Also he said that at the beginning of the hearing the PCB representative spoke that in today's hearing the matter related to EIA will discuss. So he said that the EIA report is available at Panchayat office, DI & CC, DC office and it has 284 pages and he go through the pages and point out some mistakes. He said that by criticizing, it does not mean that he is against the expansion unit. The mistakes he find out are in the plant location, about Reserve forest and NDZ area is not mentioned in the EIA report. In the EIA report

did not properly mentioned that after expansion water will be extract from
Shanniri river will become more so what steps they will take and also
said that if river dries up what affect it will fall on living being. and
Excess gas will burnt in the ground level or in the Top level. He also said
that if large volume of waste water will discharge through Sengamorgian
than whether it will affect the people or not. There will be pollution and
so greenbelt is necessary but properly not mentioned in the report about
greenbelt according to his views. He further allege NRL authority that
they did not absorb local youths in job. He atleast said they should keep
NRL as Public identity not as Private identity. Though he raised some
objections but he is in favour of the project.

The President of the Public Hearing ask NRL authority to clarify the

Nridul Phukan, Asom Jatijabadi Yuva Chatra Parishad (AJYCP), Golaghat Zila spoke that inspite of unfavourable weather many peoples attended the hearing and so he ~~feels~~ is pleased. From the startling of NRL many development works taken place in that area and NRL is built as a result of blood given by 855 martyrs but he allege that NRL authority didnot made any Sewahid bedi inspite of asked by various organisations and request the NRL authority to build one Sewahid bedi before startling the expansion project. ^{Heam} spoke in favour of the project and ask NRL authority to absorb local youths in the expansion project.
