

Report on Swachhata Hi Sewa (SHS) 2023 Activities Undertaken by Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL)

As part of its commitment to social responsibility, NRL organized various Swachhata activities as part of Swachhata Hi Sewa (SHS) 2023, a fortnight-long cleanliness campaign observed nationwide from September 15 to October 2, 2023.
