

Reply to Parliament Question No 10772 for 10.08.2023 for Lok Sabha regarding “CNG Pumps in Jharkhand” in respect of Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL):

Q no. (a): whether it is a fact that the number of CNG operated vehicles is increasing in the country, particularly in Jharkhand and the attraction of the people towards CNG is on rise;

Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL) is a Public Sector Enterprise with a 3.0 MMTPA petroleum refinery at Numaligarh in Golaghat district of Assam. Present shareholding pattern of NRL is Oil India Limited (OIL) – 73.27%, Govt. of Assam (GoA) – 22.88% and Engineers India Ltd (EIL) – 3.85%.
