Q. No. (a): whether the ministry has upgraded the Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL)

from Schedule B to Schedule A CPSE and if so, the details thereof;

Reply: Department of Public Enterprise, Govt. of India has approved the upgradation

of Numaligarh Refinery Limited from Schedule B to Schedule A CPSE in June,

2023.

Q. No. (b): whether NRL is currently implementing a mega refinery expansion project to

triple its refining capacity to 9 MMTPA;

Reply: NRL is implementing its refinery expansion project from 3 to 9 MMTPA with its

associate crude oil pipeline from Paradip, Odisha to Numaligarh, Assam &

Crude Oil Import Terminal at Paradip.

Q. No. (c): if so, whether the NRL laying a trans-national crude oil pipeline from Paradip

in Odisha and if so, the details thereof;

Reply: As a part of Numaligarh Refinery Expansion project, NRL is laying a 26"dia

crude oil pipeline of length 1635 KM from Paradip in Odisha to Numaligarh in Assam for transporting imported crude oil. The crude oil pipeline will pass

through the states of Odisha, West Bengal, Jharkhand, Bihar and Assam.

Q. No. (d): whether NRL is currently implementing projects involving investments to the

tune of Rs. 35,000 crores in the region and if so, the future expansion plan of

NRL;

Reply: NRL is currently implementing the following major projects approved by Govt.

of India:

Further, NRL is implementing a 360 KTPA Polypropylene Project and its associated facilities at an estimated cost of Rs. 7,231 Crores. Environment Clearance for the project is being obtained.

Q. No. (e): whether the upgradation to Schedule A now make NRL eligible to achieve the

status of Navaratna; and

Reply: With upgradation to Schedule A CPSE, NRL is now eligible to apply for the

status of Navaratna. NRL meets all the criteria for upgrdation to Navaratna

CPSE.

Q. No. (f): if so, the role of NRL in the current energy transition mission in the oil and

gas sector in the country?

Reply: NRL needs to keep itself ready for future energy transition scenario by

decreasing its transportation fuel product portfolio and increasing petrochemicals and specialty chemicals. NRL, also proposes to develop a long-term roadmap to achieve Net Zero by 2040 with respect to 'Scope 1' and 'Scope 2' emissions by implementing low-carbon or renewable projects like production of Green Hydrogen, 2G bio fuels and various carbon reduction

projects.

For these twin objectives NRL will require to invest in many new projects. Categorization as a Navaratna CPSE will give NRL the much-needed financial

autonomy to execute new projects.
