

Reply to Parliament Question No 4443 for 07.08.2023 for Rajya Sabha regarding “Petrol and Diesel Prices” in respect of Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL):

Q no. (a): Cost per litre for refining diesel and petrol by the Indian refiners during last three years;

[Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL) calculates cost per liter of refining diesel and petrol, on an annual basis, as per Cost Records in compliance with Companies (Cost Records & Audit) Rules, 2014 and applicable Cost Auditing Standards. The cost derived for last three financial years for Petrol and Diesel is as under.

[NRL refines Crude Oil and produces various petroleum products such as HSD, MS, SKO, ATF, LPG, Wax, CPC etc. Crude is input into Crude Distillation Unit (CDU) and is further refined in secondary processing units to produce the above products. On an annual basis cost is calculated as per Cost Records in compliance with Companies (Cost Records & Audit) Rules, 2014 and applicable Cost Auditing Standards, and the same is provided in reply to Q no. (a).]

Q no. (c): Tax, cess, surcharge, excise duty, etc. per litre on diesel and petrol collected by the central government during the last three years; and
