- 1. **Past Experience** of having successfully completed similar works* during last 5 years ending last day of the month, proceeding the month in which bids are invited should be either of the following:-
 - ➤ One similar work costing not less than **Rs.13.22** Lakh or
 - > Two similar works costing not less than **Rs.10.58**# **Lakh** each or
 - ➤ Three similar completed works costing **Rs.7.93 Lakh** each

Note: The bidder must submit copy (ies) of relevant Work Order(s) and Completion Certificate(s) along with the un-priced bid in support of the above criteria.

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^{*}Similar work in Govt. / PSU / Reputed Private Organization in last five years".

^{*} The Value of past experience be adjusted at a simple rate of 7% for every completed year and/ or part thereof ending last day of the month preceding the month in which bids are invited

It is to be noted that experience as main contractor will only be taken cognizance of for the purpose of assessing qualifying criteria. However, authorized sub-contractors under principal contractors can also be considered provided their works completion certificate is issued by the client organization in case of job executed elsewhere under PSUs, limited companies, Government Departments, Quasi government and autonomous bodies. However, in case of sub-contractors under contractors engaged by NRL, the works completion certificate issued by the main contractor will also be acceptable provided the same is endorsed in original by Engineer-in-charge of NRL in terms of job description and value.

For accepting experience as sub-contractor(s) or contractors under Private Organizations, in addition to the requisite certificates (letter of award and job completion certificate etc.)TDS certificate issued by principal contractor / private organization shall form the basis for considering experience and value of work executed.

2. Average Annual Financial Turnover during the last three years ending 31st March of the previous financial year, shall be at least **Rs.7.93 Lakh.** The bidder must submit copy (ies) financial documents – Trading and P/L account(s) along with the un-priced bid in support of the above criteria.

Offer will be considered only when NRL is satisfied with experience and capability of the tenderer to take up this work.

- **1.** Bidder should have following valid documents to be submitted along with the technical Bid on the date of Closing of tender.
 - (i) Income Tax PAN number.
 - (ii) GST registration number.
 - (iii) PF & ESI certificate
 - (iv) 'Integrity Pact' duly signed and stamped on each page without which offers will not be accepted.

SPECIAL NOTE TO THE BIDDERS:

The above mentioned requirement of prior turnover and prior experience will be relaxed if the bidder is Micro and Small Enterprise or Startup and meets the quality and technical specifications described in the tender, subject to submission of valid supporting documents by the bidder.

Apart from the documents listed above, bidders who are willing to avail the benefit of 'Micro & Small Enterprises' and 'Start Ups' are required to submit the following documents.

- (ii) If the bidder fails to submit MSE registration certificate mentioned above in the original tender, the bidder shall not be considered for evaluation as MSE.
- (iii) The MSE registration shall be valid as on date of placement of order

For availing the benefits of 'Start Ups'

Bidder who intends to participate as 'Start-up' company should enclose the Certificate of Recognition issued by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Govt. of India.

- 6) After successful email verification please login with your user id and password
- 7) Bidder will receive system generate One Time Password (OTP) on their registered mobile number. In case not receiving of OTP please click Regenerate OTP and login.
- 8) After login Screen bidder can search the tenders and proceed for EMD payment.
- 9) Bidders' have to click on Payment Dashboard option available under Action tab
- 10) Payment Dashboard Click on Pay to proceed further for the selection of payment mode.
- 11) Smart Hub Bidders' can select the online payment and click on Pay to proceed further.
- 12) After click on Pay Bidder will get an option for Cards and Net Banking. Bidders can select their preference and proceed further for the payment.
- 13) On successful payment bidder will receive system generated message on screen stating "EMD paid successfully"
- 14) Bidders' can also download the Payment receipt from Payment Dashboard.
- 15) Downloaded payment receipt Bidders' can easily print the receipt and use it for their bidding purpose.
- 16) Since the HDFC Bank payment gateway is not under the CPPP, so the payment mode is mentioned as offline (BG) in the CPP portal. Bidder has to make a dummy entry in the EMD fields of CPPP by putting 'Transaction ID' (HDFC Bank payment receipt) as instrument no., payment date as issue date, any date as expiry date, and bank name as issuer details.
