Reply: Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL) does not have a separate budget specifically allocated for scholarships, fellowships, or sponsorships targeting exclusively SC/ST/OBC students. However, our Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives are designed to support a diverse range of communities with a focus on our operational areas of the refinery as well as Marketing Terminal at Siliguri. We have scholarship schemes for students of Class X and XII state board examinations and girl students from Class VIII to X for students belonging to the operational areas. A major portion of the population in these areas belongs to SC, ST, and OBC categories. Thereby many beneficiaries of the scholarship programs belong to these marginalized communities. This approach emphasizes a collective support system, promoting equal access to educational resources for all students.

In this regard, we would like to inform you that M/s Assam Bio Ethanol Private Limited (formerly Assam Bio Refinery Private Limited) ("ABEPL") is a joint venture private limited company incorporated under the Companies Act, 2013. As a private entity, the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005, are not applicable to us. However, as a matter of good faith, we are providing the following point-wise information related to Assam Bio Ethanol Private Limited:

 - iv. Carbon dioxide – 32000 MT
 - v. Bio coal – 160000 MT.
- The average daily raw bamboo requirement: Approx.1500 MT
- The raw materials required for production are:
 - i. Dry bamboo – 300000 MT/Year
 - ii. Formic Acid – 4000 MT/Year
 - iii. Enzyme – 1600 MT/Year
 - iv. Urea – 800 MT/Year
 - v. Ammonia – 800 MT/Year
 - vi. Yeast – 1.2 MT/Year

- The total anticipated cost for setting up this plant: Approx. INR 4200 crores.
- INR 3200 Cr belongs to plant & machinery with constructions cost and INR 90 Cr belongs to technology license fee.
- The project has been delayed as per the current schedule due to the adoption of a new process technology at the bio-refinery, which utilizes bamboo as raw material. This technology is being scaled up for the first time from a pilot project to commercial operations. The commissioning is now anticipated by March 2025.
- Total area covers by the plant: 10.50 Hecter.
